ITEF Grant Brings Technology to Central

Last year our school applied for and was awarded a competitive technology grant from the Innovative Technology Education Fund. The grant, totaling \$60,000, enables students at CVPA to expand their educational horizons by introducing new technology to course curriculum. The grant has allowed us to purchase 10 desktop MACs, over 80 tablets, and we are working on installing a recording studio.

Mr. Bova, resident technology guru, is managing the grant and teaching a journalism course that will regularly utilize the new equipment.
