Random Acts of Kindness

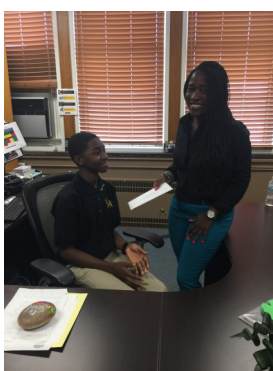


Teachers were given kindness coins to distribute for random acts of kindness. The idea was to pass the kindness and the coin on.
