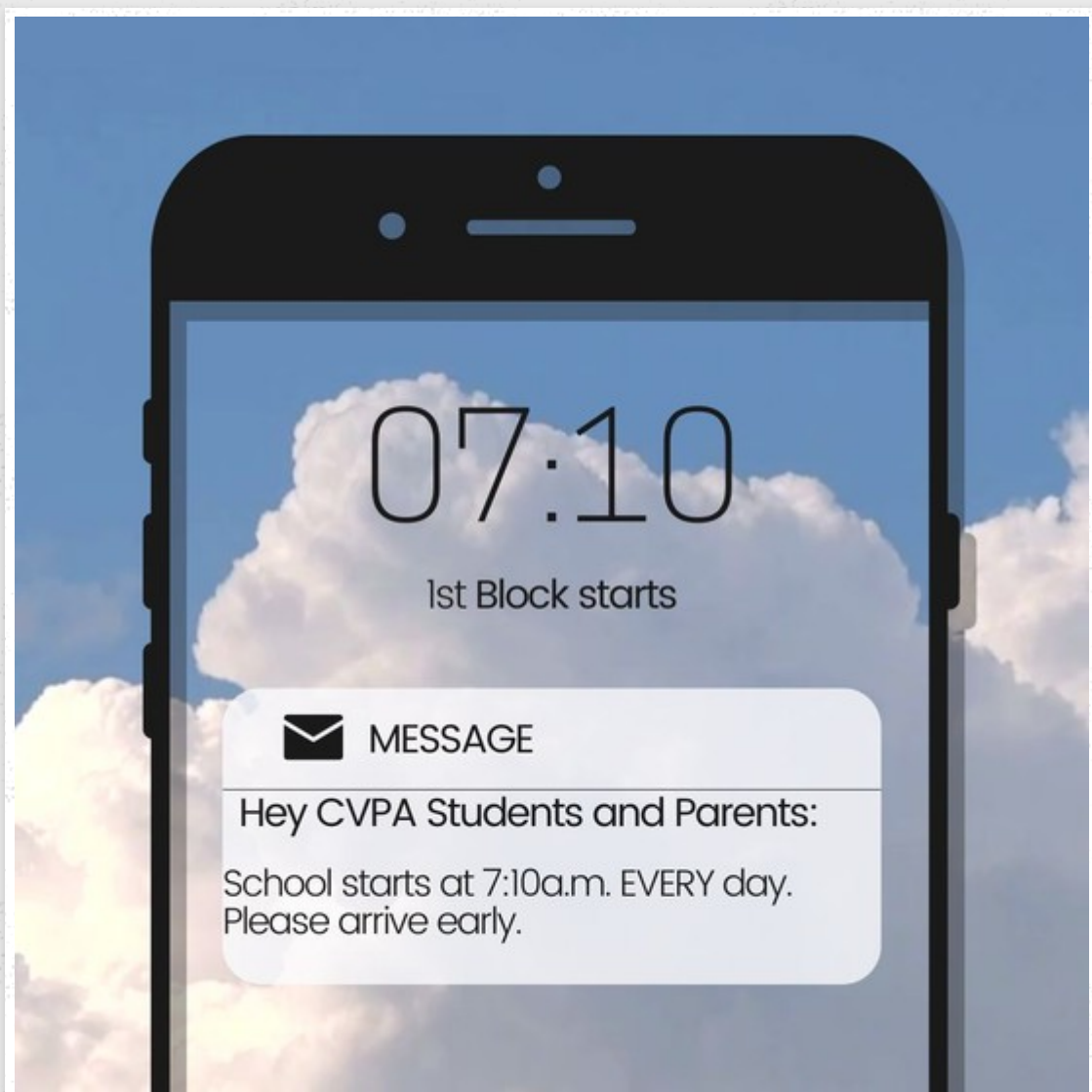

PLEASE BE ON TIME EACH DAY

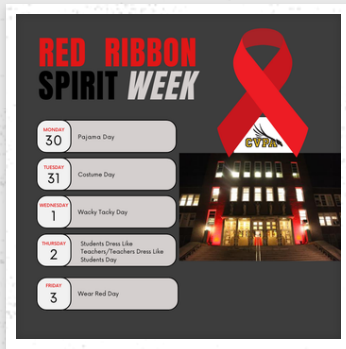

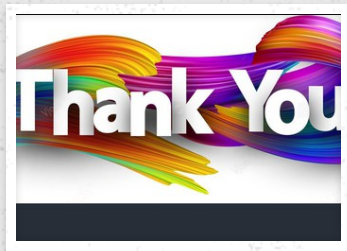
JAZZ CONCERT TO BENEFIT CENTRAL VPA BAND PROGRAM

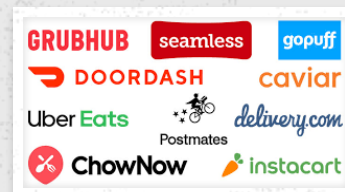

Since 2017 The Soul Box Project has been raising awareness of the U.S. gunfire epidemic, helping communities create meaningful activities by making and exhibiting thousands of hand-folded origami Soul Boxes representing victims. Soul Box exhibits visually showcase the true extent of the U.S. gunfire epidemic. Each Soul Box holds a physical space for a life lost or injured by gun violence, defense, accident, or suicide. People across the country have made and sent us thousands of hand-folded origami boxes: Soul Boxes remember individuals lost or injured by any circumstance of shooting: violence, defense, accident, or suicide. Soul Boxes represent and honor people of every race, cultural background, gender identity, sexual orientation, and religious or political affiliation. Our display is just a very small representation of the lives affected at CVPA due to gunfire.

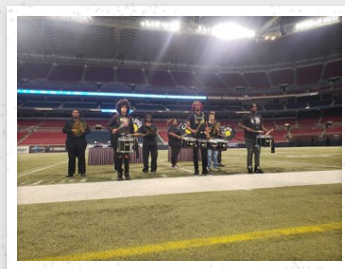
2023 KEVIN COYNE SAFETY ART CONTEST WINNERS

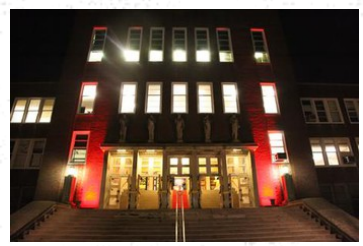
