How to care for your iPad

Avoid placing weight on the iPad. Never throw or slide an iPad. Never expose an iPad to long-term temperature extremes or direct sunlight. An automobile is not a good place to store an iPad. Keep the iPad away from liquids.

iPad Case

The iPad comes with a school issued case. The purpose of the case is to protect the iPad. The iPad must remain in its school issued protective case at all times. No stickers or any other items should be attached to the iPad itself.

iPad Battery & Charger

The iPad should be charged, using ONLY the provided wall charger. Families are encouraged to setup a safe iPad charging space in their home for their child to charge the iPad daily. Fully charged iPad batteries will typically last ten hours of use. It is the student's responsibility to charge the iPad daily and ensure it is ready for use each day. Failure to do so may result in the student's inability to participate in classroom learning activities. If there seems to be a problem with the charger at home, first try moving the charger to a different wall outlet. If the iPad still will not charge or is not working correctly, **please email**<u>techhelp@slps.org</u>. Phone chargers and non-Apple tablet chargers may not provide the correct voltage to the iPad, and over time will degrade the iPad's performance.

iPad Screen

The iPad is an electronic device; handle it with care. While the iPad is scratch resistant, it is not scratch proof. Avoid using any sharp object(s) on the iPad. The iPad screen is glass and is vulnerable to cracking. Never place heavy objects on top of the iPad and never drop your iPad.

Avoid applying liquids to the iPad. The iPad can be cleaned with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth or dry microfiber cloth. Avoid getting moisture in the openings. Do not use window cleaners, household cleaners, aerosol sprays, solvents, alcohol, ammonia, or abrasives to clean the iPad. The iPad can be wiped with a Lysol wipe.

iPad Tracking

The iPad has software on it to manage and track the location of the device if it becomes lost or missing. Please notify us immediately at <u>techhelp@slps.org</u> and call your principal. A police report needs to be filed.
