- We would like to welcome our new 4th grade teacher, Ms. Danielle Wohlstadter! Ms. Wohlstadter is eager to work with our learners this year and is oozing with excitement. She has been in training with the rest of the team gearing up for virtual instruction.
- You should have received an email from your child's teacher regarding our Virtual Open House. If not, a flyer is attached to this email. Specifics will come from the classroom teacher.
- The district has assured that we will be 1:1 with technology. Students in grades K-5 will receive iPads and a charger.
