Starting early

Dunbar provides an education-driven preschool for three- to five-year-old children to get them ready for school. And we make it fun. Your child will learn basic skills through interactive play and how to resolve conflicts in a respectful way. Specialized classes are also available for developmentally delayed children.

Watching them grow

Once children are ready for kindergarten, they'll be set on a path to reach their education goals – and have plenty of support along the way. We will create a plan, track your child's progress and keep you informed. Tutoring support ensures our children have the extra attention they need so they don't fall behind.

Our teachers are committed to helping your child succeed. They will get to know your child, establish high expectations and provide needed resources. We know that not all children learn at the same pace or in the same way. That's why our teachers are trained to match their teaching to each student's learning style and to group students to better meet learning needs through small-group instruction.

Providing extra help

We understand the challenges you face raising a child, and we're here to help:

- **Before-school program** lets families drop children off early and gives them the right start with a good breakfast.
- After-school program offers a safe, supportive environment for children who have working parents. Professional tutoring through the Millennial program gives students help in reading and math twice a week and provides parents a monthly progress report.
- **Big Brothers, Big Sisters program** connects children with mentors to give them extra attention and augments learning through educational games.
- **Tutors** from Wells Fargo Advisors and Americorp visit daily to help students with reading and math.

Families matter at Dunbar. We recognize the importance of parents and work to strengthen the connection between home and school for all students:

- As a **Home Visit School** we make sure we're connected to our students and families.
- Our parent specialist holds monthly meetings, and a **behavior specialist** is on staff to help work through discipline problems or other family issues.
- Family Nights at school help you stay engaged and involved in your child's education.
- The school's library has a section of books just for parents.
