



SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 2 SCHOOL PLAN

SCHOOL: Lyon @ Blow Academy

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Five-day-a-week in-person instruction or virtual learning, based on parent/guardian selection

CLASSROOM CAPACITY: Approximately 13 students. Larger classes may be held in larger spaces, such as the library or gym. At all times, we will follow social distancing guidelines.

SCHOOL HOURS: 8:05AM – 2:02PM

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE: Students arriving via bus will enter Door 10. Students being dropped off or walking to school will enter Door 10. Parents must remain in their vehicles. Only students will be dropped off on Virginia side and keep a safe distance from peers. Pre-K students will be dropped off and picked up from Door 3.

DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE: Temperature will be checked at the entrance door and in the classroom upon arrival.

MEALS: Breakfast and lunch will be eaten in the classroom.

VISITOR PROCEDURES: Parents are not allowed in the building for pick-up and drop-off. All visitors are encouraged to call ahead and make an appointment. Only one visitor at a time will be accepted. All visitors must enter Door 1 and pass screening. Parents and guardians will not be able to visit classrooms.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: At dismissal, parents/guardians will drive by on the Vermont side to pick-up students. Parents will remain in the car. A staff member will walk the student to the car and sign off on the name.
