désirer: to want to

devoir: to have to/must
écouter: to listen to

penser: to intend to
pouvoir: to be able to/can
préférer: to prefer to
prétendre: to pretend to

PLACE OF NEGATION

- Around** the conjugated verb
*Il n'oublie **jamais** de siffler pendant le match.*
- Before** the infinitive

INFINITIVE INSTEAD OF PRESENT PART (subject)

***Être** un enfant n'est pas facile.*
***Being** a child is not easy.*

INFINITIF

VERBE + À + INFINITIF

aider à: to help to
s'amuser à: to pass time by
apprendre à: to learn to; to teach to
arriver à: to manage to
commencer à: to begin to
continuer à: to continue to
encourager à: to encourage to
s'habituer à: to get used to
hésiter à: to hesitate to
inviter à: to invite to
se mettre à: to begin to
réussir à: to succeed in
tenir à: to insist on

PLACE OF PRONOUNS

Place pronouns before either the conjugated verb or infinitive, depending on which one they are the object of. Do not contract à and de.

*Je **l'**ai entendue chanter.*
*Tu n'oublieras pas **de le** faire.*
*Vous préférez **ne pas leur en** parler?*

Often used to give instructions
(recipes, public signs)

Mettre au four pendant 15 min.

PAST INFINITIVE (avoir/être + pp)

used after **APRÈS**
*Après **avoir crié**, j'ai pleuré.*
*Après **s'être promenée**, elle était bien.*
NB: review pp agreement

VERBE + DE + INFINITIF

accepter de: to accept to
arrêter de: to stop
choisir de: to choose to
conseiller de: to advise to
décider de: to decide to
demander de: to ask to
dire de: to tell to
empêcher de: to prevent from
essayer de: to try to
être obligé(e) de: to be required to
finir de: to finish
s'occuper de: to take care of
oublier de: to forget to
permettre de: to permit to
promettre de: to promise to
refuser de: to refuse to
rêver de: to dream about
risquer de: to risk
se souvenir de: to remember to
venir de: to have just
avoir besoin de: to need to
avoir envie de: to feel like
avoir hâte de: to be impatient to
avoir l'intention de: to intend to
avoir peur de: to be afraid to
avoir raison de: to be right to
avoir tort de: to be wrong in (doing sth)
*il est + **ADJ** + de...*

Some verbs usually take an IO before de + inf
commander, conseiller, demander, dire,
permettre, promettre, suggérer
*Maman **lui** a demandé d'acheter à manger.*

SUBJUNCTIVE VS INFINITIVE

(2 subjects vs 1 subject)
*Il veut que **nous** allions à la plage.*
Il veut aller à la plage.
