

## HYPOTHETICAL CLAUSES

### SEQUENCE OF TENSES (same as in English)

IF + PRESENT, FUTURE  
IF + IMPARFAIT, CONDITIONAL  
IF + PLUS-QUE-PARFAIT, PAST CONDITIONAL

*If I go, I will be happy.*  
*Si j'y vais, je serai content(e).*  
*If I went, I would be happy.*  
*Si j'y allais, je serais content(e).*  
*If I had gone, I would have been happy.*  
*Si j'y étais allé(e), j'aurais été content(e).*

## SI CLAUSES

IF = SI

SI + IL = S'IL

## DON'T MISTAKE HYPOTHETICAL CLAUSES WITH REGULAR CLAUSES WITH IF

*Si tu ne comprends pas, pose des questions !*  
*Si tu ne comprends pas, j'espère que tu poseras des*

IF + PRESENT, IMPERATIVE/PRESENT

## NO ORDER OF CLAUSES

IF CAN BE IN THE FIRST CLAUSE, OR THE SECOND. THE SEQUENCE OF TENSES REMAINS THE SAME.

*Je m'amuserai, si j'y vais.*  
*Je m'amuserais, si j'y allais.*  
*Je me serais amusé(e), si j'y étais allé(e).*

## OTHER USES OF SI

SUGGESTION: SI + imparfait = WHAT IF

*Si on allait au zoo demain? What if we went to the zoo tomorrow?*

EXPRESSION OF WISH OR REGRET: SI + imparfait = IF ONLY

*Ah! Si j'étais plus grand, plus beau, plus riche! If only I were taller, more handsome, richer!*

SI = WHETHER

*Ils ne savent pas encore s'ils vont en vacances ou pas.*  
*They don't know yet whether they are going on vacation.*

Saying YES to a negative statement

*Mais si, je t'ai dit que ce produit était nuisible à l'environnement.*  
*But yes, I told you that product was harmful to the environment.*
