

SYNOPSIS OF THE QUARTER 2 SCHOOL PLAN

SCHOOL: Froebel Elementary School

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN: Five-day-a-week in-person instruction or virtual learning, based on parent/guardian selection. Live-streaming model of hybrid instruction. Most children will keep the same teacher and the same class of kids. Some students will get a new teacher, and will definitely have new students in the class with them. Your child will participate from the classroom either with the teacher or virtually with added support from a dedicated staff member assigned to that class. Your child will participate in the same work, whether they attend virtually or from the classroom with the teacher. Your child will actively participate in class through a two-way "live-stream" in Microsoft Teams, if attending virtually. For five days per week, your child's work, applications, and times per day will be the same as all other classmates, whether they attend in person or virtually. Your child will have their related arts teacher come to their classroom. Your child will have recess with their classroom only, monitored by teacher or staff. Your child will receive any needed and approved supports and related services, where applicable.

CLASSROOM CAPACITY: 12-15 students. At all times, we will follow social distancing guidelines.

SCHOOL HOURS: 9:20AM – 3:17PM

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE: NO parents will be allowed inside the building! Arrival begins at 9AM. Upon arrival, the student's temperature will be taken at the door. An adult must sign-in PK students. PK: enter at Door 5 (on Winnebago). Grades K-2: Enter at Door 6 (on Winnebago). Grades 3-5: Enter at Door 1 (main entrance on Nebraska). All students arriving after 9:20AM should enter at Door 1.

DAILY HEALTH PROCEDURE: All students (PK-5) are required to wear masks that cover their noses and mouths all day and on the bus, unless eating, napping, or actively engaging in physical activities. Staff and students will have temperature checks upon arrival. If students are exhibiting ANY of the following signs of illness (running nose, chills, shakes, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste, fever, shortness of breath, cough) or have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, they should not be sent to school. The school is following all city mandates regarding social distancing.

UNIFORMS: Students must wear a uniform to school every day.

I-PAD: Students must bring their fully charged i-Pad to-and-from school every day.

MEALS: PK and K students will have **breakfast** in the classroom delivered by the cafeteria staff. Grades 1-5 will get a Grab-n-Go **breakfast** upon entering the building, and eat in their classroom. Students will eat **lunch** in the classroom. PK and K students will have lunch in the classroom delivered by the cafeteria staff. Grades 1-5 will be escorted by their teacher to get lunch from the cafeteria, and bring it back to the classroom. **Students are encouraged to bring their own refillable bottle of water!**

VISITOR PROCEDURES: NO in-person visitors will be allowed in the building. In the event that your presence is needed or requested, an appointment must be made in advance with the front office. Upon arrival, enter Door 1 and pass the health screening.

EARLY DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: Upon arrival to school, call the main office. Student will be sent down to meet you at Door 1. **No early dismissal will be allowed after 2:30 PM.** After 2:30 PM, refer to Dismissal Procedure for Pick-up.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE: Dismissal procedures will be done by grade level.

Walkers: at dismissal time, 3:00 PM.

- **Grades 3-5**: Exit at Door 1, 3:00 PM.
- **Grades K- 2**: Exit at Door 6, 3:03 PM.

<u>Pick-up</u>: 3:05 PM - 3:17 PM. Students will remain in classroom until parent arrives, and then be called down. After 3:25 PM, come to Door 1 for pick-up.

- **PK**: Exit at Door 5 (Winnebago), after parent sign-out.
- **Grades K-5**: Exit Door 2 (courtyard, on Nebraska Avenue).

Bus-riders: Students will remain in classroom until bus arrives, and will exit Door 6.
