PARENTAL AGREEMENT Student Transportation and Attendance as per the McKinney-Vento

This Parental Agreement confirms that your child _______ is enrolling in a St. Louis Public School under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act reauthorized 2015 by Every Student Succeeds' Act (ESSA). Your child may attend school in our district during the current school year ______ under the following guidelines:

- 1. If you move (change address), you must contact SLPS' Homeless Coordinator, Deidra C. Thomas-Murray at 314-345-5750. Please provide your name and telephone number where you can be reached.
- 2. Transportation may/can be available under the McKinney-Vento Act while you lack stable housing at the address which you enrolled. Transportation is only available (unless preauthorized) from the address which you enroll and to and from the school your child attends. All modifications to transportation must be handled through the Students-in-Transition Office (SIT). Any abuse of this privilege may/can result in an interruption of your child's transportation resource.
 - If you move into a permanent residence as defined under the McKinney-Vento Act, your child remains eligible for services until the end of the school year. Please contact SLPS' SIT Office at 314-345-5750 to reassess your transportation needs. If your child wishes to remain until the end of the school year, we only ask that he/she attends school daily, on time, and adhere to transportation guidelines. Any acts of aggression, threats or violence will result in immediate cancellation of transportation (until investigation is completed). Mask must be worn throughout your child's transport.

If there are challenges with your child's attendance, tardiness, early pickups, no go's with transportation, an assessment will be made to determine if your child should continue to attend school in our district.

3. At the end of each school year, all transportation ends. Your child is expected to enroll from their current address.
