

Designed for **second semester high school seniors**, this Boeing funded program provides 208 hours of employer-specific instruction in aircraft assembly techniques for Assembly Mechanic positions at Boeing.

Students will be eligible for an interview with Boeing once the following criteria have been met:

- Successful completion of the training program
- · High school graduation
- 18 years or older

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Submit a resume; When you're ready to apply, send your resume to boeingtraining@stlcc.edu. The subject line of the email should read "Boeing HS Class." Deadline for resume submission is Oct. 29, 2021.
- · Attend mandatory information session
- Submit a letter of recommendation from high school signed by a teacher, counselor or principal This letter must state that there is no risk of the student not graduating, no disciplinary issues, and that the school recognizes the student as a good candidate.
- Pass WorkKeys assessments
- Pass Layout/Measuring assessment
