Welcome Back to Our School Building 2020-2021

I'm glad to announce that Herzog Elementary will start an in-person instructional model from **8:15 am-2:12 pm** for PK- 2^{nd} grade students beginning Monday, October 19th and 3rd-5th grade students beginning Monday, October 26th with students that selected an in-person model. Due to in-person capacity restrictions, virtual students will continue virtual learning for the entire 2nd quarter.

All students will have to follow the new guidelines put in place due to COVID-19. Below are the guidelines:

- MASKS AND SAFETY Students and staff will be required to wear a mask at all times. Parents, please send your student(s) with two (2) masks: one to wear and one for emergencies.
 - Students must remain in their assigned work areas and keep their hands to themselves.
 - Emergency masks will be available.
- SCHOOL DAY– For arrival, students will enter in *their assigned doors* starting at **7:45am** where their temperatures will be taken, hands sanitized, students will take a grab-and-go breakfast, and report to class. All students will eat lunch in the classroom. For dismissal, the students will be called down to their assigned doors for bus or parent pick-up starting at **2:00pm**. Once students are home, they are expected to work on their daily on-line lessons.
 - Arrival Mimika Ave. Door (PreK-1st grade)
 - Arrival Pamplin Pl. Door (2nd-5th grade)
 - Dismissal Walkers and Pick-up, Pamplin Pl. Door
 - Dismissal Bus Riders, Mimika Ave. Door
- EARLY DISMISSAL/CHANGES TO USUAL PICK-UP Early dismissal is by 1:30 p.m. If you do not arrive before 1:30 p.m., you may pick your student up at the normal dismissal time. If you need to change your pick-up plan, or you need an early dismissal, you must call the office by 1:00 p.m. *There will be absolutely no exceptions to these policies.*
- BUILDING PROCEDURES FOR PARENTS Due to COVID-19 and new SLPS regulations: Parents, are required to call and/or schedule an appointment to visit. All visitors will be required to wear mask and complete the health screening prior to entering the building. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact, Ms. Helton (school secretary) in the office. She will direct you to the right person, or schedule an appointment for you, if needed. - **ATTENDANCE** is very important. For your child to continue in-person learning, they must be present and on time daily. If attendance becomes a concern, your child is subject to return to virtual learning and their in-person placement will be given to another student.
- **COVID-19 SAFETY** is very important. For your child to continue in-person learning, they must adhere to wearing face coverings and social distancing. If COVID-19 safety becomes a concern, your child is subject to return to virtual learning and their in-person placement will be given to another student.
