



Camp Cultural Leadership: Looking for Rising 7th, 8th and 9th graders

A two-week summer day camp for rising 7th and 8th graders. Camp Cultural Leadership includes an overnight trip to Memphis . A three-week day camp for rising 9th graders will include an overnight local retreat and an overnight trip to Chicago. These camps introduce and reinforce social justice concepts and tie them to leadership skills, similar to our award-winning high-school program. Both camps will be

held at Brittany Woods Middle school in University City.



In our first year, 23 Camp Cultural Leadership students came from 13 different middle schools. Through daily teambuilding activities regardless of background, school, or house of worship - students bonded with one another and developed lasting friendships.

Two camp sessions available:

2-Week Session for rising 7th & 8th graders: July 6 to July 17.

3-Week Session for rising 9th graders: July 6 to July 24.

Camps run from 9:30am to 3:00pm. Before- and after-care available.

During camp students engage in a curriculum focused on critical thinking skills, understanding social justice issues, developing leadership abilities, reinforcing empathy and caring for others, making new friends, and having FUN! Daily activities include get-to-know-you games, social justice learning, reflection journaling, service projects, and guest speakers.

Camp Cultural Leadership partners include: Brittany Woods Middle School (host), Adventure Tree, Jewish Community Relations Council, Think Tank Theater, and more!
