


## TEACHERS HAVE ALL CURRICULAR MATERIALS AND LESSON PLANS READY FOR EXECUTION


#### ELEMENTARY ENROLLMENT: FALL 2018, 2019, 2020






#### **MIDDLE ENROLLMENT:** FALL 2018, 2019, 2020






#### **HIGH ENROLLMENT:** FALL 2018, 2019, 2020



#### ALTERNATIVE ENROLLMENT: FALL 2018, 2019, 2020


