














WHERE DO OUR STUDENTS GO? 2019-20 WITHDRAWALS



In 2011, the SAB identified four factors to determine which schools should be **consolidated** or **transformed**:

- 1. Capacity Utilization and Enrollment
 - Elementary 75% Utilization
 - Middle 60% Utilization
 - High 50% Utilization
- 2. Accreditation Performance (Academics, Attendance, Graduation, College and Career, etc.)
- 3. Age and Condition of Building
- 4. Feeder Patterns/City-Wide Development Plans


