Note: The average daily on time performance AM and PM is 93%. Transportation has been challenged by a shortage of drivers and driver absenteeism. We are reporting a daily average of ten combined AM, and fifteen PM routes and twelve uncovered routes. The FirstView App notifies parents, and we offer students cab services and ₁₀ rescue buses.

 - Grab and Go Carts for Breakfast: 24 Elementary Schools, 6 Middle Schools and 11 High Schools
 - Grab and Go Carts for Lunch: 2 High Schools
- Child and Adult Care Feeding Program (CACFP)
 - Afterschool Supper and Snack Programs (25 elementary, 2 middle and 6 high schools)

*2020-2021 Covid-19 Pandemic – Less Students Served, 27 schools were opened (Meal Distribution Sites) but due to the decrease in participation new currently operate 18 sites. We are serving Grab and Go bags for families.





PreK-5th ENROLLMENT: OFFICIAL MEMBERSHIP COUNT DAY 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022




6TH – 8TH ENROLLMENT: Official Membership Count Day 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022


