## Highlights

### **MPI Increases**

- 22 MPI point increase in 3<sup>rd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> grade in ELA
- 20 MPI point increase in 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> grade in Math
- 77 MPI point increase in 8<sup>th</sup> grade math to 9<sup>th</sup> grade Algebra I



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- **Continuous Improvement** 
  - Continued with above 90% in Follow-Up Positive Placement (100% of the points)
  - CCR Results are in the 50% range for both College Placement assessment or Dual Enrolled & Dual Credit
  - Earning 50% of the points in graduation rate






# **Closing Comments**
