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

# HISTORY OF MISSOURI ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (MAP)

- □ Created in 1993 Outstanding Schools Act
  - Began with grade span assessments
    - □ 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> in Communication Arts
    - □ 4<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> in Mathematics
    - □ 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> in Science
- □ No Child Left Behind 2001
  - Required annual assessments in Communication Arts & Math for 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade and once in High School
  - Phased in approach with Science
    - □ Assessed in 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and once in High School

# HISTORY OF MISSOURI ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (MAP)

- □ 2008–09 End of Course Assessments
  - □ Algebra I, English II & Biology
- **2009–10** 
  - □ American History, Government, English I, Algebra II & Geometry
  - On-Line method of delivery
- **2014–15** 
  - Grade level also provided in on-line method

- ☐ Multiple changes in test questions have occurred since 1993 ☐ Grade Level Assessments (GLA) □ Show Me Standards ☐ Grade Level Expectations (GLE) □ Course Level Expectations (CLE) ■ Missouri Learning Standards (MLS) ☐ Common Core — Race to the Top requirements (Smarter Balance/PARCC) ☐ Data Recognition Corporation (DRC) ■ Missouri Learning Standards (MLS) □ Field Tests
- □ Inside each of these, there were changes in question types, skills assessed, scoring modifications along with additions & removals of specific assessments (due to scoring anomalies)

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# SUMMARY FROM 2018-2019 APR



- □ ELA 76.8% of our elementary schools saw significant growth
- □ Math Almost 70% of our elementary schools saw significant growth
- Math 50% of our middle schools saw significant growth
- □ High School Follow-Up 85.7% of our high schools achieved in the "On Track or Exceeding Level"
- ☐ High School Graduation Rate 64.3% of our high schools achieved in the On Track or Exceeding Level

#### 2019-20

 No APR was produced due to waiver from Federal Government for MAP & EOC

#### 2020-21

- Assessments were given
  - □ All were in-person
  - □ Reduced test questions by 25%
  - More Flexibility extended windows
  - 85% participation rate was expected
  - Will allow a window in the Fall to reach this participation (if needed)

### 2020-21 (continued)

- DESE will share scores
  - State, District, School Level
  - □ Through a Report Card format
- Due to COVID-19 impact, no APR will be produced (2<sup>nd</sup> year)
- Longitudinal comparisons will not be possible
- Districts can use results to assess
   the need for individual student
   support

## **MSIP VI**



- □ Approved in February, 2020

- □ Anticipate to receive 2 APRs for the 2021-22 and 2022-23 school year
  - One with MSIP V
  - One with predicted MSIP VI
- □ MSIP VI APR only in 2023-24 accreditation purposes
- Provides an opportunity for Districts to anticipate
- No metrics have yet been set for MSIP VI
  - District has been on the committee in previous iterations


