FINANCIAL OBJECTIVES



- Maintain Full Accreditation

- Maintain long-term financial stability with a 30% fund balance
- Reinforce a culture of high expectations and accountability



FY2024 FUND CATEGORIES

- □ General Operating Budget (GOB) 70%
 - Largest Percentage of District Budget
 - Nearly 90% Taxpayer funded with Property and Sales Taxes
- □ Grant Budgets 23%
 - Local: SLPS Foundation, Parsons Blewett, Simon
 - State: Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE), CTE Performance,
 Parents-As-Teachers
 - Federal: Title I, II, III, IV; Special Education, Food Service, Adult Education, Perkins, ECSE, ESSER III
- □ Debt Service Budget 7%
 - Interest and Principal Payments
- Bond Funds
 - Proposition S General Obligation Bonds





FY2024 NEW INITIATIVES:



- □ Salary Increases +3%
- □ GOB School Discretionary Model Weighted Student Formula (IEP, ELL, SIT, etc.)
- □ Proposition S General Obligation Bonds \$135M



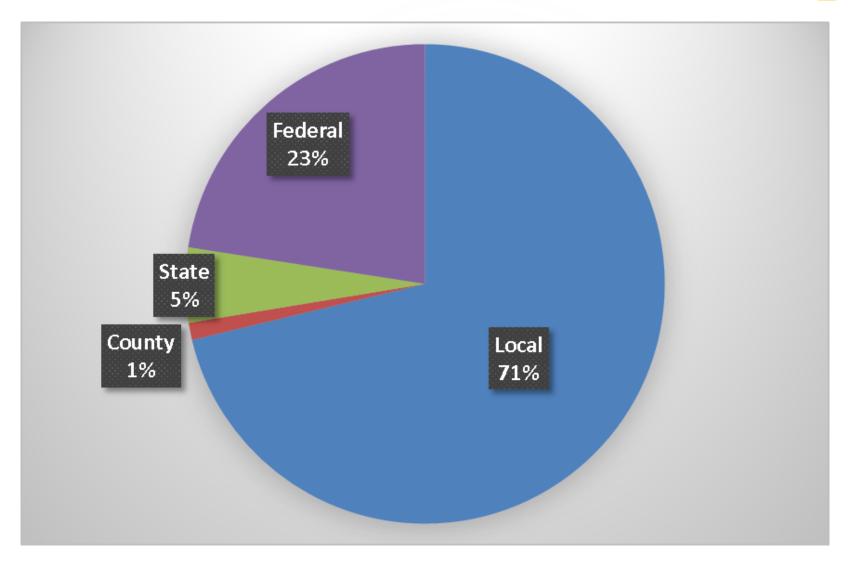
