2. 3rd Grade Math Growth and Proficiency

College and Career Readiness:
 High school students prepared for workforce and post-secondary employment

4. Culture and Climate: Student Wellbeing





 The percentage of 3rd grade students scoring Proficient or higher will increase from 21.8% to 39% by May 2026 as measured by the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP).\*

\*DESE recommended growth is 3 percentage points each year; SLPS to double this growth each year



<mark>3rd</mark>	<mark>14.5%</mark>	<mark>16.9%</mark>	<b>21.8%</b>



**23-24**: The percentage of 1st grade students scoring in at least the 50th Percentile Rank (PR) will increase from **40% to 50%**, as measured by STAR Reading.

**24-25**: The percentage of 2nd grade students scoring in at least the 50th Percentile Rank (PR) will increase from **50% to 60%**, as measured by STAR Reading.



25-26: The percentage of 3rd grade students who are Proficient and Adyanced (on MAP) will show an increase at the 50th percentile rank or higher from 60 % to 70% as measured by STAR Reading.

### Flagship Goal 2: 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Math



 The percentage of 3rd grade students scoring Proficient or higher will increase from 17.1% to 40% by May 2026 as measured by the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP). \*

\*No DESE recommended growth percentage each year; SLPS reviewed regional and national trend data and research reports and identified a minimum of 7 percentage point growth each year.



**23-24:** The percentage of 1st grade students scoring in at least the 70th Percentile Rank (PR) will increase from **17% to 28%**, as measured by STAR Mathematics.

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**24-25**: The percentage of 2nd grade students scoring in at least the 70th Percentile Rank (PR) will increase from **28% to 39%**, as measured by Renaissance STAR Mathematics.



**25-26**: The percentage of 3rd grade students who are Proficient and Advanced (on MAP) will show an increase at the 70th percentile rank or higher from **39% to 50%** as measured by STAR Mathematics.

## Flagship Goal 3: College & Career Readiness (CCR)



• The 4-year graduation rate will increase from 69% in 2023 to 80% in 2026 and the percentage of graduating seniors (Class of 2023-2026) who are "positively placed"\* will increase from 90.4% to 93%, as measured by the DESE 180-Day Graduate Follow-Up Report with a special focus on identified student groups currently below the 90% positive placement rate.

\*Positively placed is a DESE designation that includes **Enrollment** in College/University or Trade/Technical School;

**Employment**; **Enlistment** in Military Service

- 1) The percent of graduates who engage in a rigorous career pathway\* will increase from 43.3% to 45%
- 2)The percent of students in grade 8-12 with an Individual Career & Academic Plan (ICAP) by the end of the school year will increase to 90%
- 3)The percent of SLPS 9th graders who complete the school year with at least 6 credits and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will increase from **71% to 76%**.

24-25

- 1)The percent of graduates who engage in a rigorous career pathway\* will increase from 45% to 48%
- 2)The percent of students in grade 8-12 with an Individual Career & Academic Plan (ICAP) by the end of the school year will increase to 92%
- 3)The percent of SLPS 9th graders who complete the school year with at least 6 credits and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will increase from **76% to 80%**.

25-26

- 1)The percent of graduates who engage in a rigorous career pathway\* will increase from 48% to 50%
- 2)The percent of students in grade 8-12 with an Individual Career & Academic Plan (ICAP) by the end of the school year will increase to **95**%
- 3)The percent of SLPS 9th graders who complete the school year with at least 6 credits and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will increase from **80% to 82%**.

#### Flagship Goal 4: Student Wellbeing



The percentage of 6th and 9th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging (connectedness to school and adults) will increase from 33% to 63% (6th grade) and from 32% to 62% (9th grade), as measured by Panorama Survey results.

• 1) The percentage of 6th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging will increase from 33% to 43%, as measured by Panorama.

• 2) The percentage of 9th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging will increase from 32% to 42%, as measured by Panorama.

24-25

- 1) The percentage of 6th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging will increase from 43% to 53%, as measured by Panorama.
- 2)The percentage of 9th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging will increase from 42% to 52%, as measured by Panorama.

25-26

- 1)The percentage of 6th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging will increase from 53% to 63%, as measured by Panorama.
- 2)The percentage of 9th grade students who report feeling a sense of belonging will increase from 52% to 62%, as measured by Panorama.
