In Saint Louis County...

- Over 5% of middle and high school students attempt suicide each year
 - 1 in 18 students, 1 in every classroom
 - 13 students per day
- Over 30% of students are bullied within 12 months
- In Saint Louis Metro...
 - 35-40 youth (15-24 years old) die by suicide every year

 - 4 schools
 - 27 students
 - 182 counseling sessions



FAMILY SUPPORT

- Licensed clinicians provide support through:
 - Strategic Solution Focused Family Centered Counseling to kids in crisis
 - 8-16 sessions help kids leave crisis
 - Counseling in office (866 sessions) or in schools (2847 sessions, 1 day per week in 32 schools)




Tele-Behavioral Health Services

Tele-behavioral health is the process of providing psychotherapy remotely, utilizing HIPAA-compliant video conferencing.

The advantages of virtual delivery of psychotherapy include reduced stigmatization, increased convenience for patients, and improved provider efficiency.

 Embedded TBH: TBH stations planted in schools with support from staff.
