CHARTER DEFINITION



A charter school is a free, independent public school that operates outside of a school district. Charter schools are granted greater flexibility in return for greater accountability. Missouri charter schools are governed by independent boards and are non-profit organizations.

CHARTER SPONSORSHIP



There are three kinds of sponsors in Missouri: school boards of accredited districts, qualifying universities and the Missouri Charter Public School Commission. Each sponsor sets their own policies and procedures for sponsorship. Sponsored charter schools must be approved by the Missouri State Board of Education and must meet all applicable state statutes and Department of Elementary and Secondary Regulations.

A charter sponsor receives 1.5% of the state and local funding allocated to a charter school (up to \$181,470.59) in order to fulfill statutory responsibilities. – RSMo 160.400, Sub-section 11

SPONSOR PROTECTIONS



A sponsor of a charter school, its agents and employees are not liable for any acts or omissions of a charter school that it sponsors...– RSMo 160.400, Sub-section 9

If a sponsor notifies a charter school of closure under subsection 8 of section <u>160.405</u>, the department of elementary and secondary education shall exercise its financial withholding authority under subsection 12 of section <u>160.415</u> to assure all obligations of the charter school shall be met. The state, charter sponsor, or resident district shall not be liable for any outstanding liability or obligations of the charter school. – RSMo 160.400, Sub-section 18

Confluence: Final Recommendation



SPONSORSHIP OF CONFLUENCE ACADEMIES Final Recommendation: ADVANCE WITH RESERVATIONS

Expectations met in Categories 1, 5, and 6.

Expectations not fully met in Category 2 (attendance rate did not meet target postpandemic). Continued monitoring and action is required.

Expectations not fully met in Category 3 (graduation rate did not meet target at one of the two schools). Disparate outcomes across the schools must be studied and addressed when sponsorship is approved.

Expectations not fully met in Category 4 (debt exposure present). An aggressive debt repayment plan that is not dependent on enrollment growth must be established and executed when sponsorship is approved.

SLPS Sponsorship



Every three years, each charter sponsor must go through a reevaluation process.

Timeline:

- Updated Handbook and Sample Charter Contract Submitted to DESE (Submitted Jan 31, 2023)
- 2. Additional Requested Documentation Submitted to DESE *(Submitted March 10, 2023)*
- 3. Received DESE Approval to resume Sponsorship Duties
- Submitted Letters from Confluence, Mizzou, and SLPS approving sponsorship transfer, effective June 30, 2023 (Submitted March 24, 2023)
- 5. Completing charter contract negotiations with Confluence (Pending- to be completed and signed no later than June 30, 2023)

SLPS Sponsorship (cont.)



Sponsorship responsibilities will include:

- Timeline of data submissions from Confluence.
- Board Meetings (monthly)
- School Visits (monthly)
- Status updates to Confluence Board (bi-annually)
- Overall evaluation update (annually)
- Status updates to DESE (monthly- hold-over from last sponsorship for Confluence)

Potential partnership opportunities:

- Offerings of Professional Development
- Shared back-office services (ex. transportation)
