- FCC Emergency Connectivity Fund (E-Rate)
- Homeless Children and Youth Fund
- \$2M Teacher Recruitment and Retention Fund
- \$103.3M American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ESSER III)
 - \$68M available with plan, total allocation will be available with an approved application and the State application has been approved by the US Dept. of Education.
- □ \$46M (ESSER II) SLPS funds

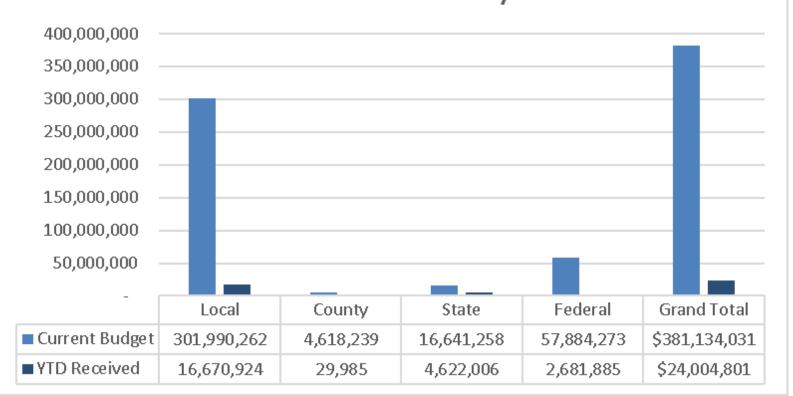

Year to Date Revenue by Source

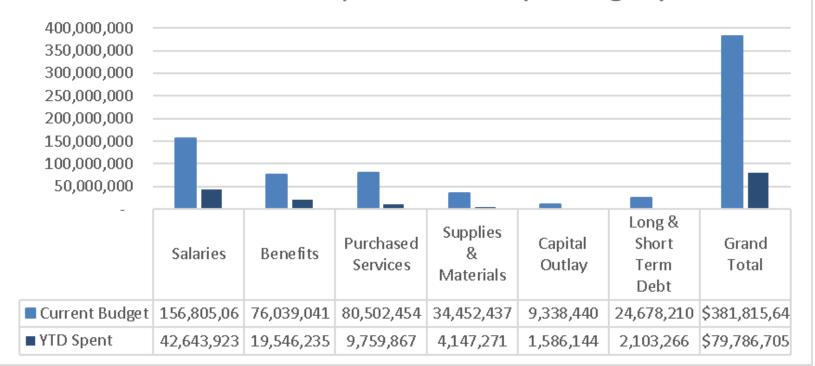
