BACKGROUND



Background: To support schools and districts in addressing the impact of COVID-19, Congress has provided financial support through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund.

ESSER II Priorities:

- ☐ Safely reopen schools for all students.
- ☐ Address pre- and post-pandemic unfinished learning.
- ☐ Build lasting, equitable systems of teaching and learning.

ESSER II: DISTRICT EXPENDITURE UPDATE

ESSER II: EXPENDITURE TIMELINE



Summer 2022:

- ☐ The Operations Department will expend approximately 50% of their budget during the summer as their projects will take place while schools are closed.
- □ Academics will expend approximately 20% of their budget in July 2022 on extra service professional development for teachers.

August-December 2022:

- ☐ The Operations Department will expend approximately 15-20% of their remaining budget on projects.
- □ Student support services will expend 40% of their remaining funds on contracted services and before/after care programs.
- □ Academics will expend approximately 50% of their remaining funds on extra service, digital licenses, and outdoor learning areas.

January-May 2023:

□ Remaining funds from all district departments will be encumbered and expended.

DISTRICT DEADLINE: June 30, 2023 is the deadline for all ESSER II encumbrances.

ESSER II: SCHOOL TIMELINE



- ☐ June 30, 2022:
 - □ 30% of school funds will be encumbered/expended.
- **☐** August-December 2022:
 - □ 60% of schools funds will be encumbered/expended.
- ☐ January-May 2023:
 - □ 90% of schools funds will be encumbered/expended.

DISTRICT DEADLINE: June 30, 2023 is the deadline for all ESSER II encumbrances.

ESSER II: SPENDING CHALLENGES



Request for Proposal (RFPs): Certain services required RFPs which creates a 3-6 month process before services can begin or goods can be acquired.

Facility Upgrades: Many projects involving facility upgrades cannot take place during the school year.

Supply Chain Issues: There are delays on many items due to the pandemic (i.e. flexible seating).

Staffing Capacity: Certain purchases such as flexible seating, require the removal of furniture in spaces. Additional staff will be required to support this process.

LOOKING AHEAD: ESSER III-ARP



The American Rescue Plan (ESSER III-ARP) was appropriated by the Missouri Legislature in February 2022.

☐ \$103 million has been allocated to SLPS

ESSER III-ARP Budget:

- ☐ 70% of funding towards direct supports for all learners
- ☐ 25% Facility Improvements/COVID Prevention
- □ 5% Professional Learning
