



STAR Training

- Renaissance returned to SLPS on December 19th and provided STAR training to school leaders.
- During the training, the focus was on reviewing growth data from beginning of year to middle of year.
- Our goal is that all principals know individual student scores and are reviewing the data with teachers on an ongoing basis.



SGP

STUDENT GROWTH PERCENTILE

An SGP compares a student's growth to that of his or her academic peers nationwide. Current SGP is calculated for students who have taken at least two tests within different testing windows. It uses the most recent test (within the past 18 months) and at least one prior test from an earlier testing window (Fall, Winter, or Spring; the dates for these windows are static and need not correspond to a school or district's school year).

FALL: AUGUST 1 TO NOVEMBER 30TH

> WINTER: DECEMBER 1 TO MARCH 31

SPRING: APRIL 1 TO JULY 31



Spring to Fall comparison







Fall to Winter comparison









Comparison of Movement












Reading and Writing Training

Beginning in January, the Chief of Schools will begin a pilot at Jefferson, Peabody, Columbia, Ashland, Meramec, and Walbridge

Each month's professional learning session will include:

a demonstration lesson (reading and/or writing),

a debriefing conversation,

collegial sharing, and

a review of student work.







Intervention Pilot

- 3rd grade students at the pilot schools will engage in weekly intervention provided by Varsity Tutors.
- Students will receive high-dosage tutoring two times a week for 30-45 minutes.
- Why high dosage tutoring?
 - High-dosage tutoring has the greatest impact on student achievement.
