

#### **Satellite Site**

- Beaumont will be used as a satellite sight for North side response call. Purpose: decrease response time to incidents, preserve building and monitor athletic practices.
- New uniforms and additional Deescalation and Mental Health training.

#### "Neighborhood Net"

- "Neighborhood Net"" bus stop initiative. Pros: presence and extra set of eyes Cons: we have 170 bus stops to monitor, removes us from daily searches at the high and middle schools (tiers)
- No capacity to handle alone.
- Stake Holders: Better Family Life,
  Urban League, 100 Black Men and interested churches.
