□ 8,000 were purchased prior to Covid-19 closure

- □ PreK 8th grade 1:1
- □ This supplemented the previous 13,000 already on hand
- General Gen

 $\Box 9^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade 1:1

- General Gen
- □ 2 in 1 Laptop refresh of Teacher laptops from 2015

*In all cases, inventory is not a concern for the District



What has been done?

 Distributed over 32,000 pieces of equipment

CURRENT STATUS



92% of our students have a District device

- □ 5% have opted out
- 3% of current have not returned their previous equipment
- 2% of the students have broken equipment
- □ 36% of our students also have a hot spot

NETWORK MODIFICATIONS



Due to Covid-19 we:

- Replaced our firewall to the latest model
- Previous equipment was 8 years old
- □ Product allows for blocking websites that are not educational appropriate
- □ Is a requirement due to our involvement in E-Rate
 - □ Child Internet Protection ACT (CIPA)

Doubled our internet speed from the District to the world wide web

- Increased the licenses on our Edge router that connects our equipment in the core network to the outside world
- Caused latency issues in some peak times throughout the day

FEDERAL E-RATE




Federal Project that funds:

- Internet connection to the world (Category 1)
- Internet connection from building to building (Category 1)
- Description And Annual Annu
- Cabling for data & phones (Category 2)
- No longer funds:
 - □ Phone lines (landlines)
 - □Cell phone lines
 - □ Phone system

If approved, District pays 10% of total costs for Category 1
 If approved, a set budget of \$50 per student for 5 years

CURRENT RFPS



- Maintenance on network
- Cabling (both new projects and repair)

WiFi upgrade

- □ All are E-Rate projects
 - Will submit for approval by Board of Education in time for March 25th deadline
 - □ Will wait for approval from Federal government
