**Position Summary:**

This is skilled work at the journeyman level in the cutting, fitting and installation of glass. Employees in this class are responsible for performing skilled glazing tasks in accordance with standard practices of the trade. Work involves cutting and preparing various types of glass for installation, setting glass in wooden or metal sash and installing, replacing and removing mirrors. Work is performed under the supervision of a Glazier Foreman and is reviewed in progress and upon completion through personnel inspection to insure that instructions are carried out and for adherence to specification and accepted craft standards.

**Essential Functions:**

- Replaces windows broken through vandalism at school buildings and a variety of other buildings; installs, removes and replaces various types of glass such as clear, graptolite, Florentine, tapestry, plate, cathedral and wire glass in windows skylights, greenhouses, hot beds, fish aquariums and display cases; and installs, removes and replaces mirrors.
- Cuts glass to size for various installations with a glass cutter; rubs edges and drills holes in glass as required; scrapes putty from frames; and set glass in metal or wooden sash using glazier's paints or metal clips.
- Removes caps from skylights and sets in new glass after preparing bed of putty; putties and replaces caps.
- Performs related work as required

**Experience:**

- Experience as a journeyman glazier; or any equivalent combination of training and experience

**Education:**

- Graduation from a general or technical high school

**Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:**

- Considerable knowledge of the standard practices, methods, tools and equipment of the glazing trade.
- Knowledge of the characteristics, qualities and uses of various types of glass such as clear, graptolite, Florentine, tapestry, plate, cathedral and wire.
- Knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions of the glazing trade.
- Ability to work at considerable heights.
- Ability to observe safety precautions in carrying out assigned tasks.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Skill in the use of standard tools and equipment of the glazing trade.
