Essential Functions:

- Manage Extra Service and Overtime Time Entry and process for Before/After Transportation Program
- Provide procurement and time entry assistance for the Before/After Care Program through Student Support Services
- Assist in monitor ESSER spending at FMO Level
- Process Budget Adjustments and help with ESSER monthly reporting
- Coordinate prompt handling of all customer service requests of any payroll or FMO requests related to ESSER
- Audit all entries by location to SAP and Kronos for compliance with established Standards
- Serve as Central Office Liaison for all ESSER spending as it related to Amazon
- Review and payroll and budget for analytical and budgetary compliance
- Other duties as assigned as it related to ESSER
