We are excited to receive all our students come August 18th. Just some important information for the upcoming school year 2025-2026. School registration is being done online this year. This is for all new and returning students. You will simply log onto SLPS website by clicking on the link <https://www.slp.org/Register>. Because SLPS has switched over to a new information system, all families must have an account in order to register students.

ONLINE ONLY—ALL STUDENTS MUST BE REGISTERED !!

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Ms. Horton in the office.

Our bell times will be from 8:20am-3:17pm. If you arrive to drop your child off after 8:15am, you will need to bring your child around to the front entrance, inside to the main office and sign them in. I will not except any late arrivals after 9:30am unless with a doctor's note. If you need to do an early dismissal, please do so by 2:15pm. You will come to front main entrance and sign your child out at our security's desk and wait for your child there. Parents will not be allowed to walk through the building to any classrooms without prior approval from administration.

If your child's transportation for home time needs to change for any reason, please contact the main office by 1:30pm to let our secretary know so that she can give advance instructions to the proper dismissal staff and your student.
