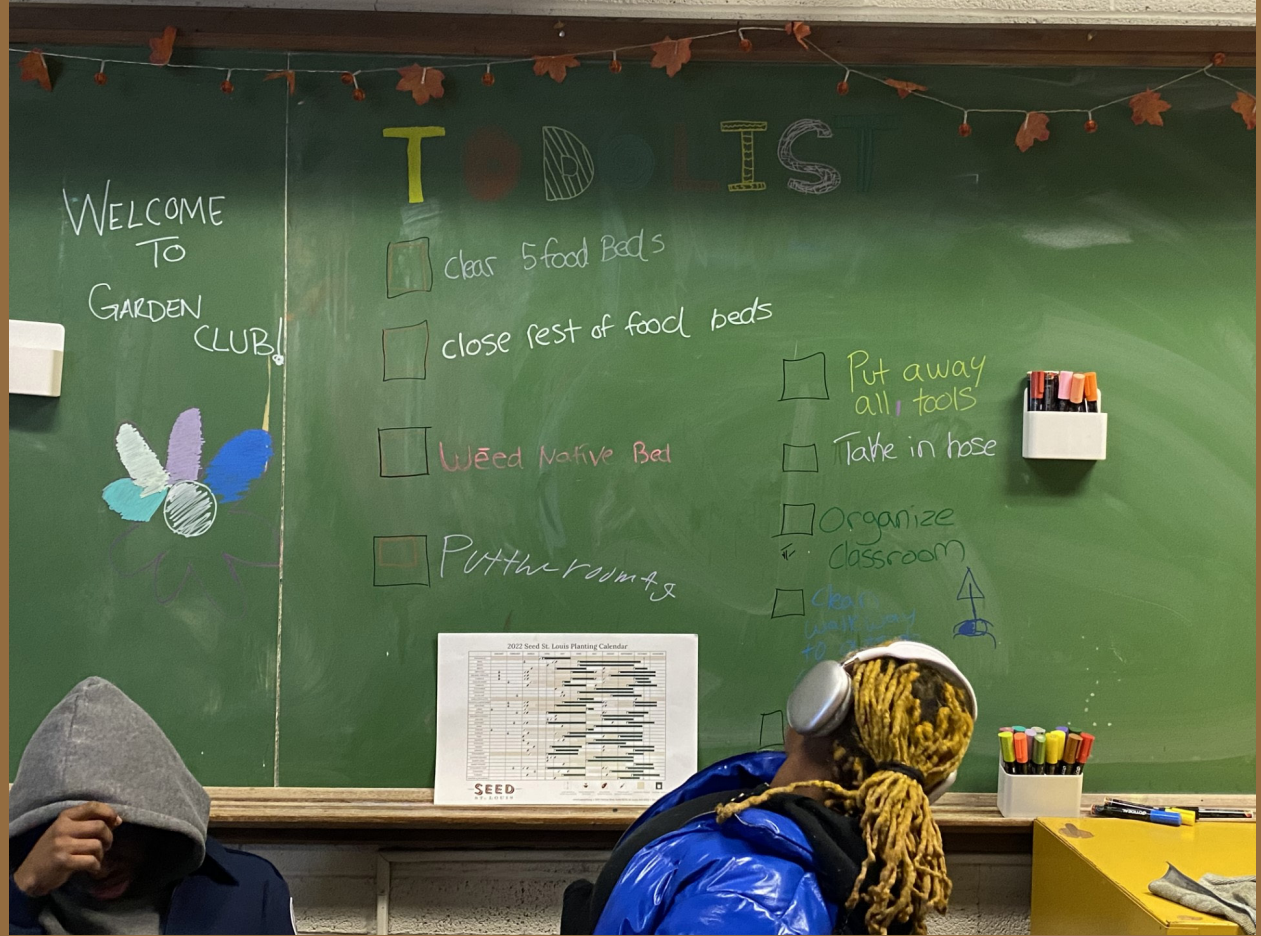
To The Rescue

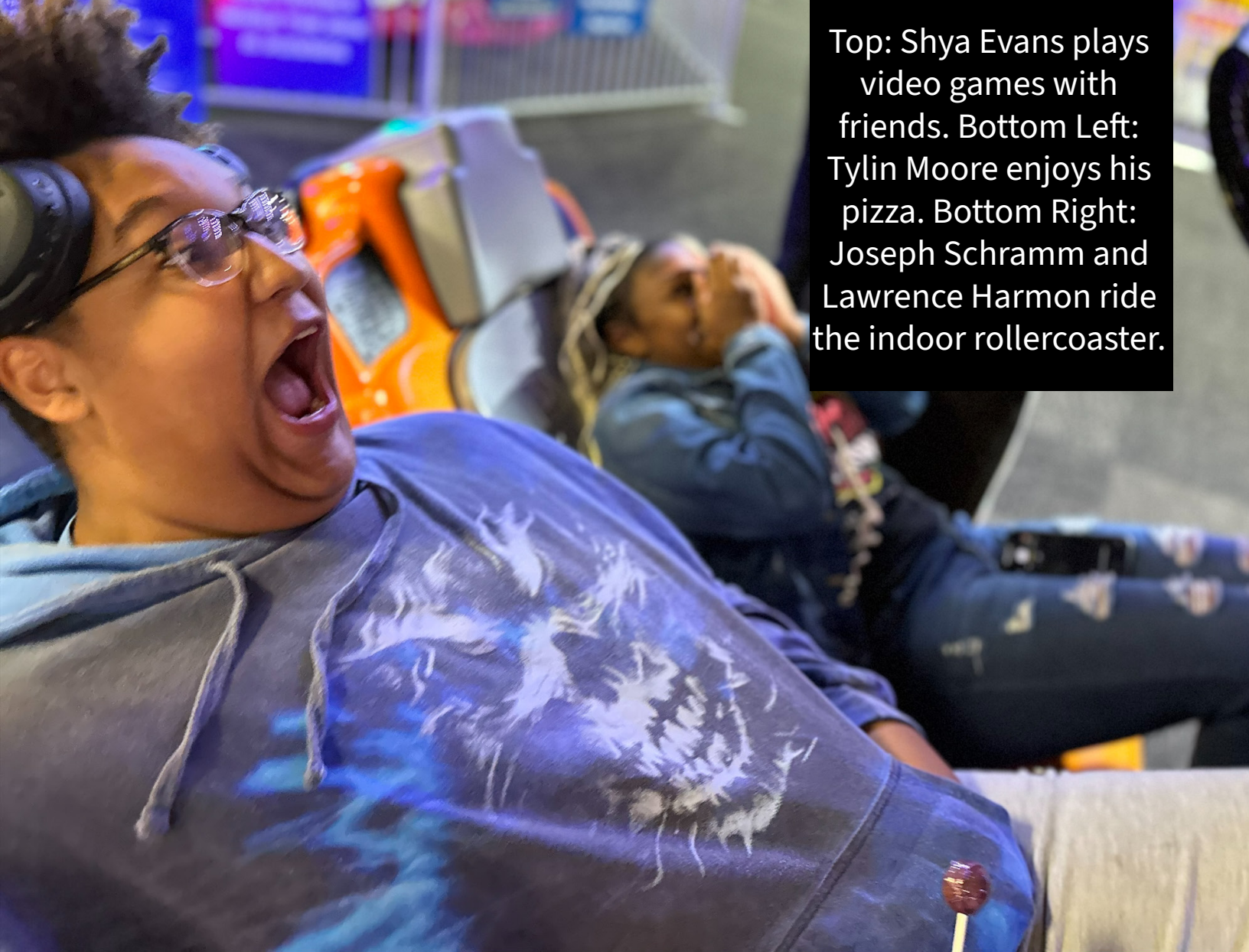

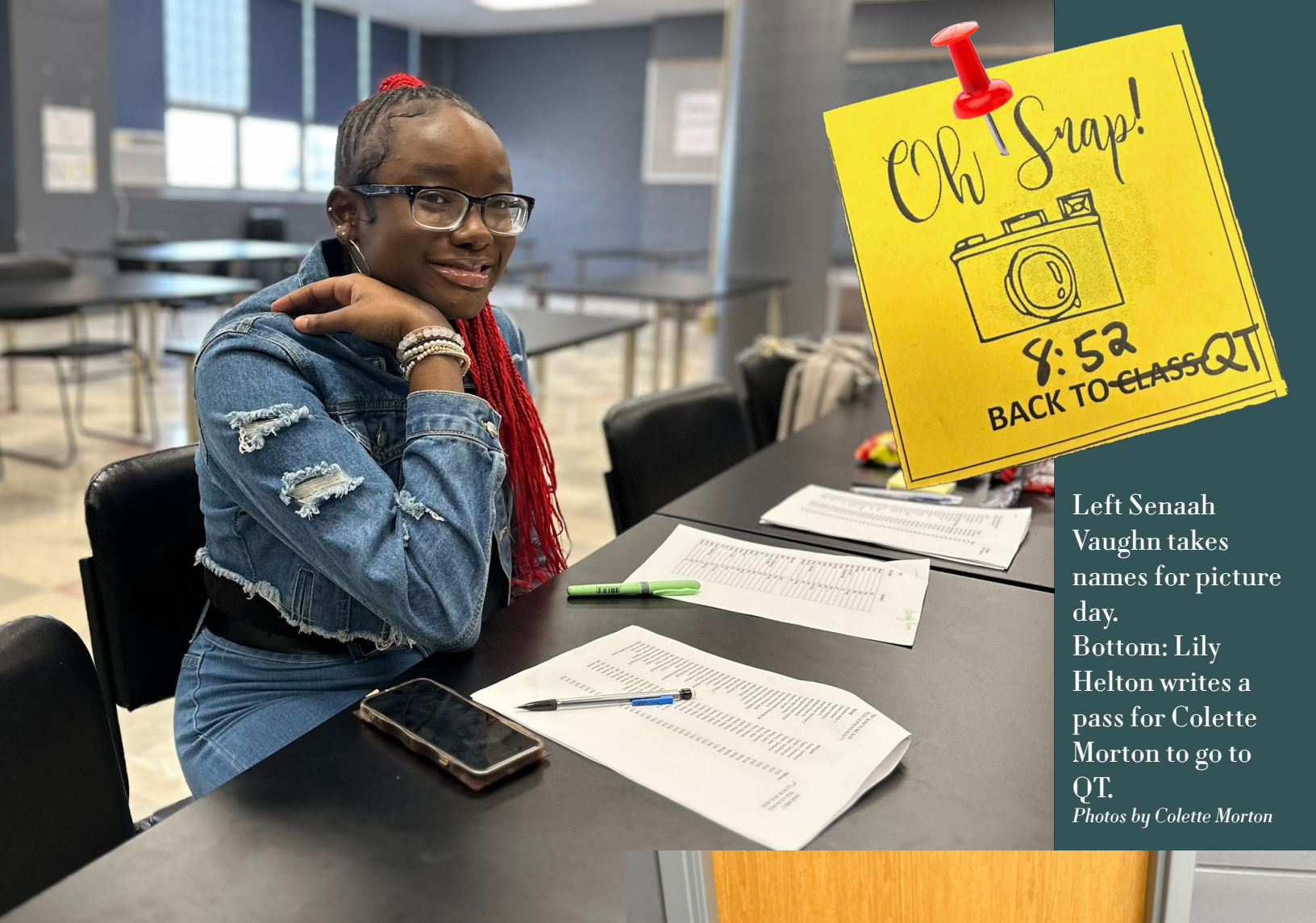

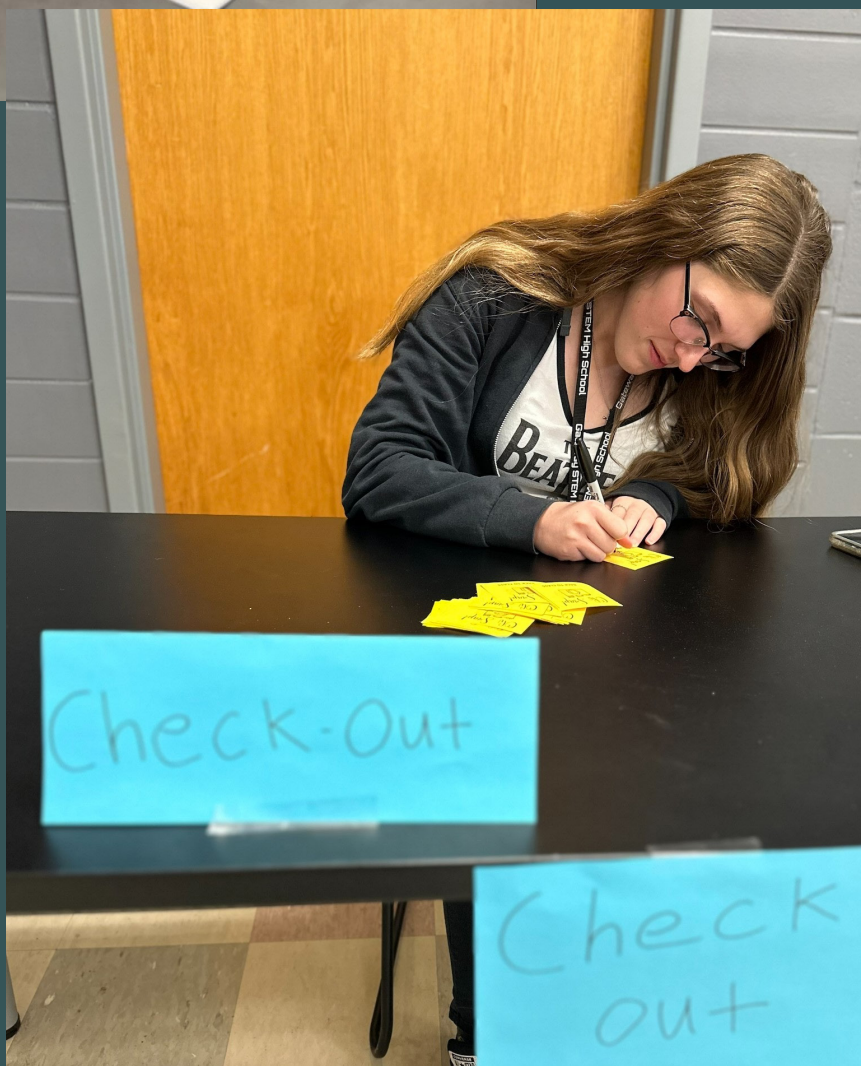

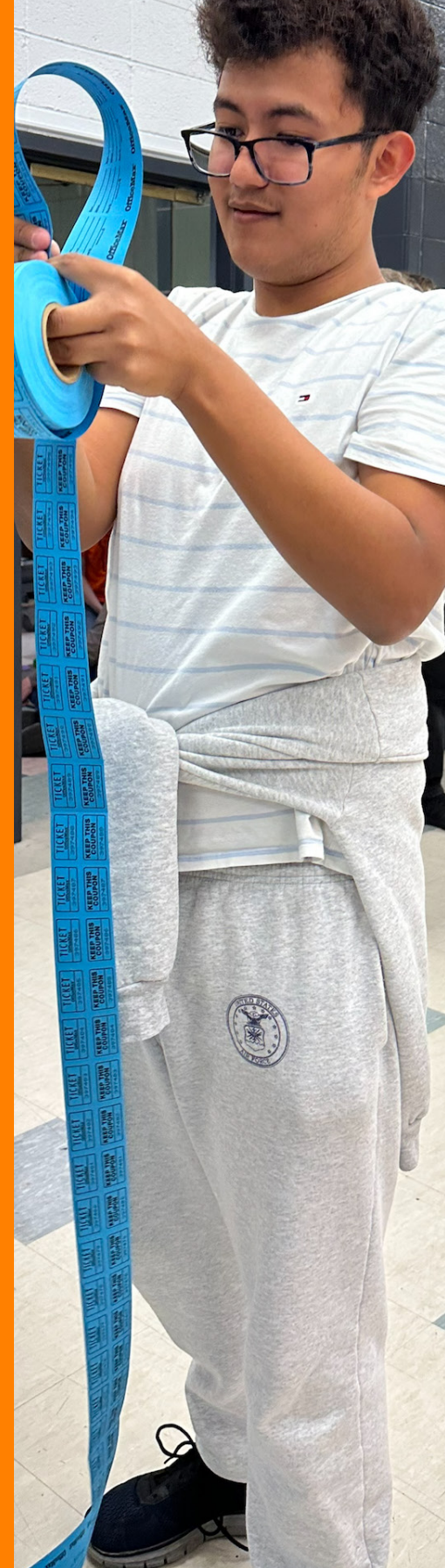

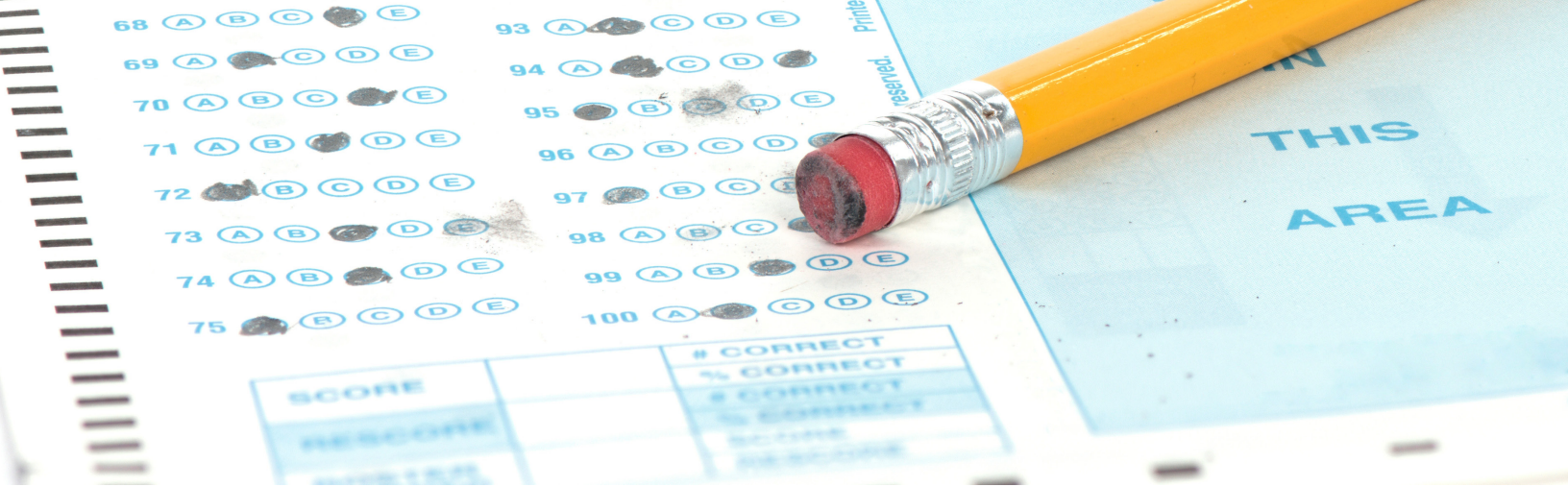
