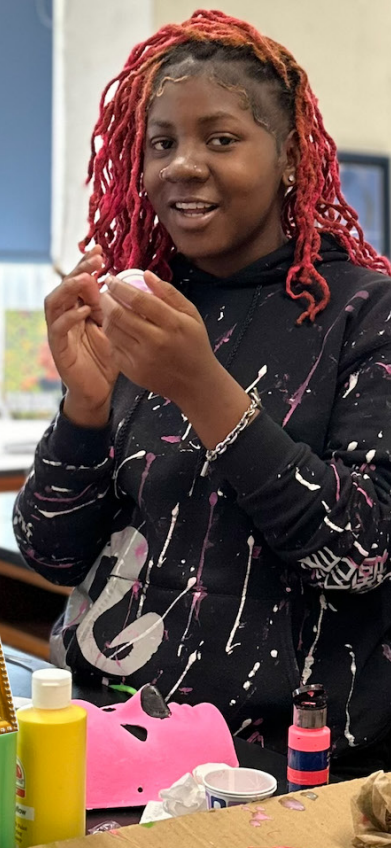

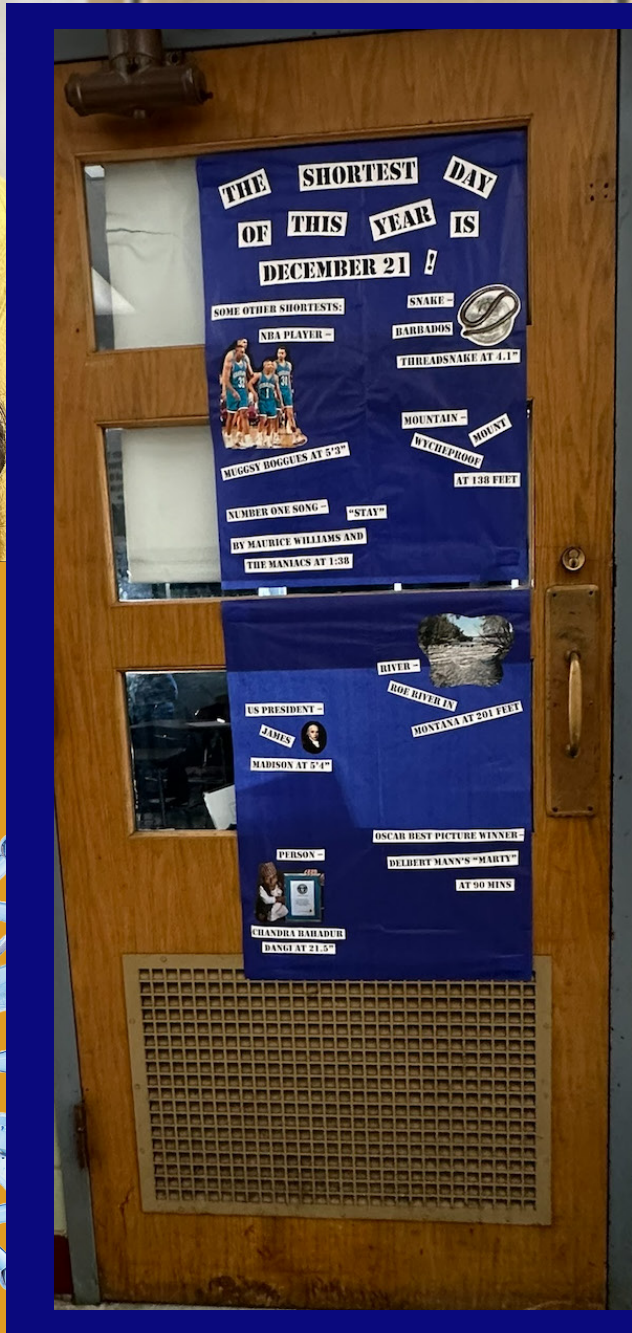

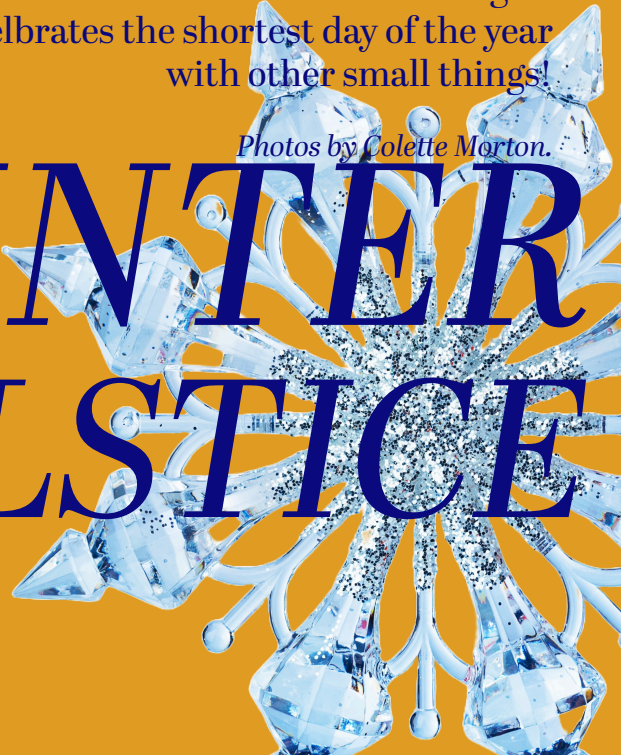

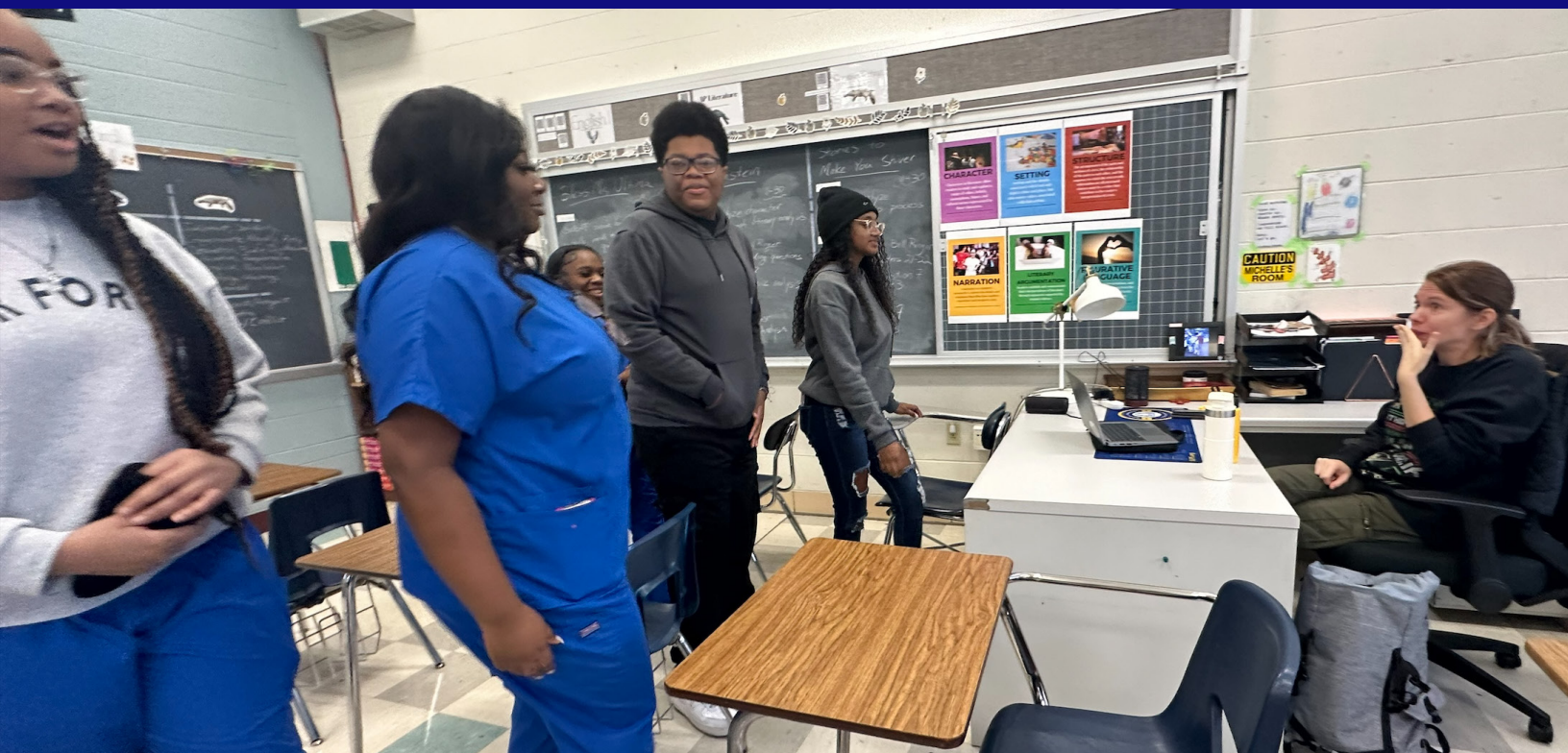

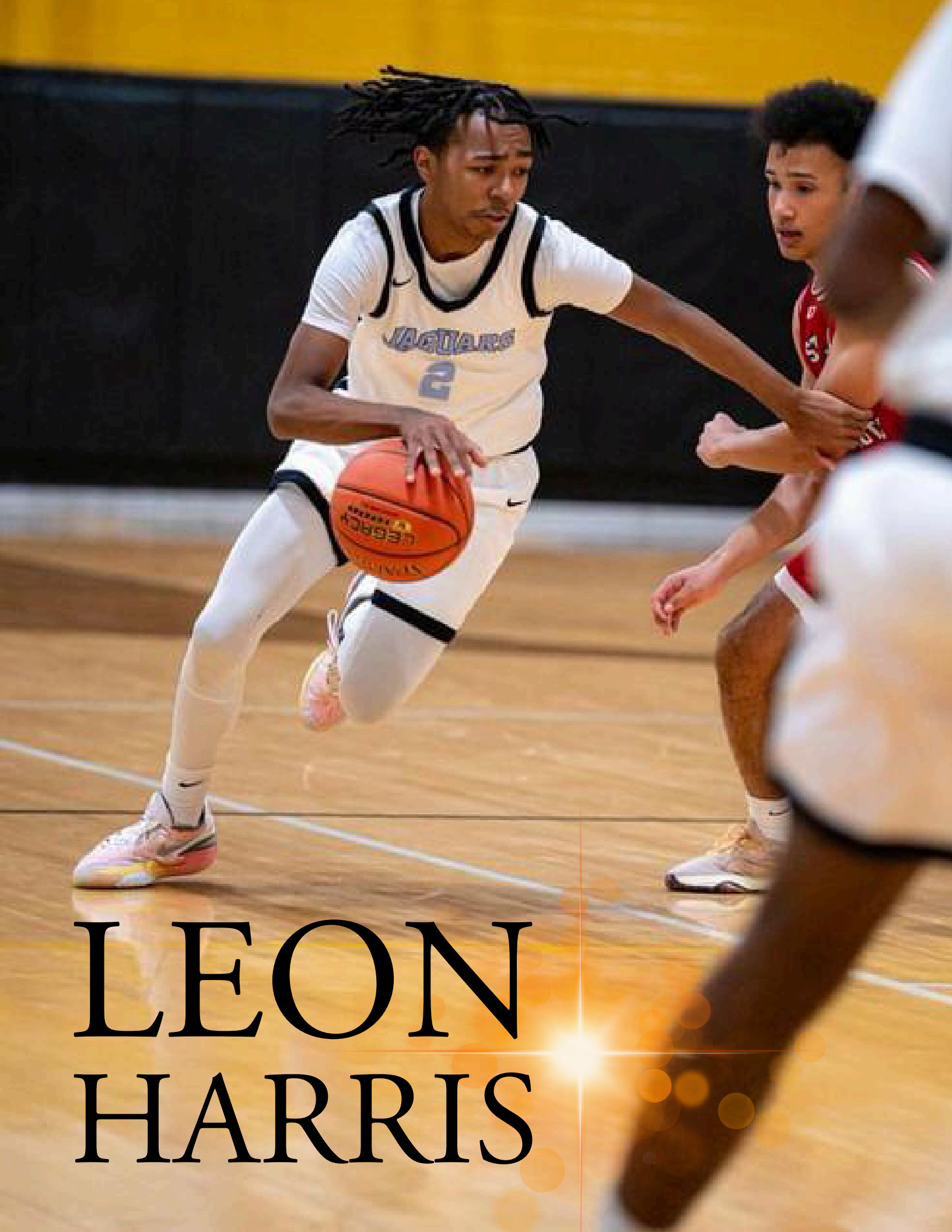

On Tuesday, November 21, 2023, Gateway STEM Jaguars boys basketball team defeated the St. Louis Patriots 65–56 in boys basketball.

Leon Harris led Gateway STEM with 29 points.

This seemed like an amazing game for the senior, and it was until December 1, 2023 when he scored 31 points against Metro. Our team defeated Metro at Vashon 57-46. The team received double-doubles from Romero Cannida (10 points, 10 rebounds) and Harris (11 rebounds).

Harris also scored 34 points against Gateway Science Academy on November 20. This is not surprise to coach John Everson. "Leon Harris worked extremely hard "over the last three years to get ready for this senior season, where he has started out as a top 5 scoring leader in the St Louis area."

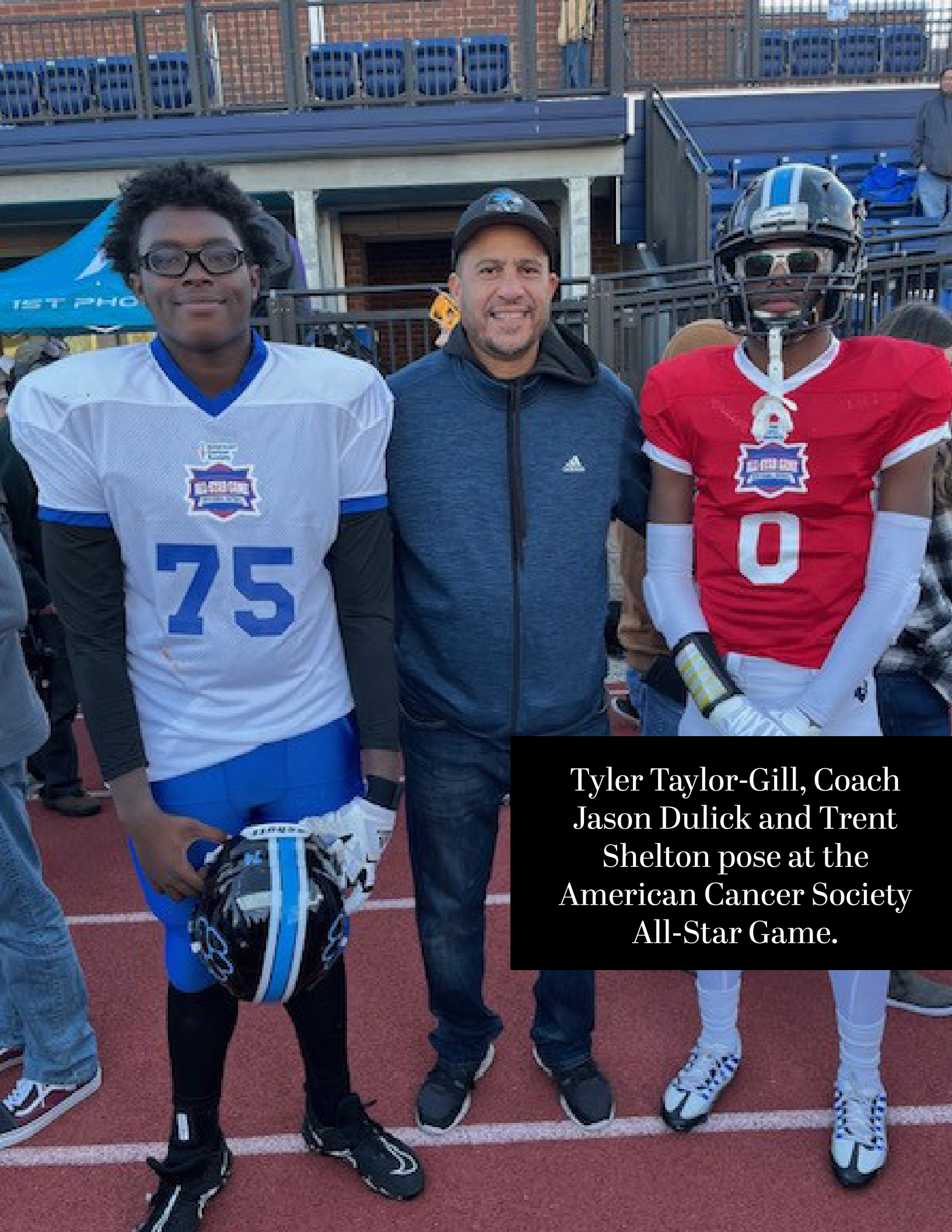

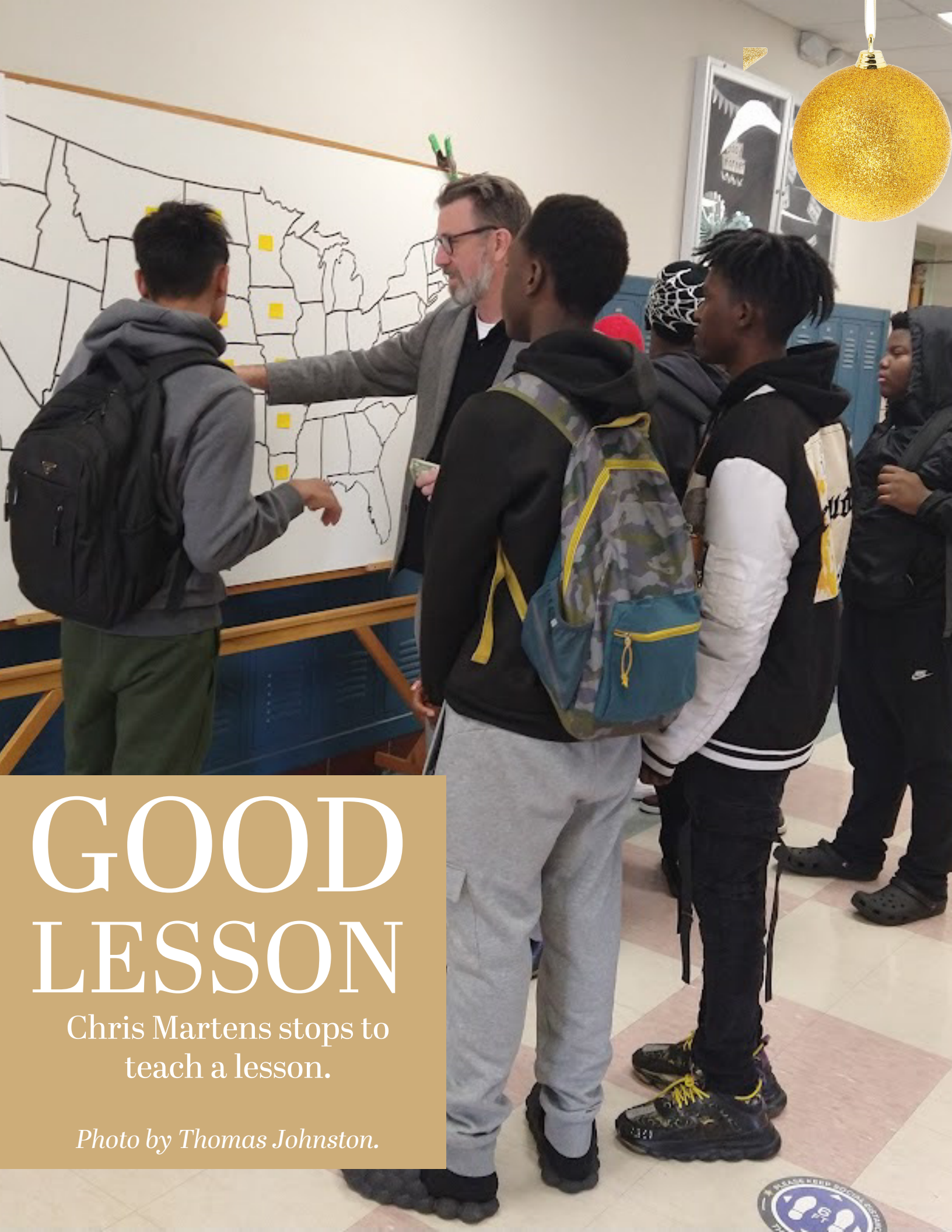

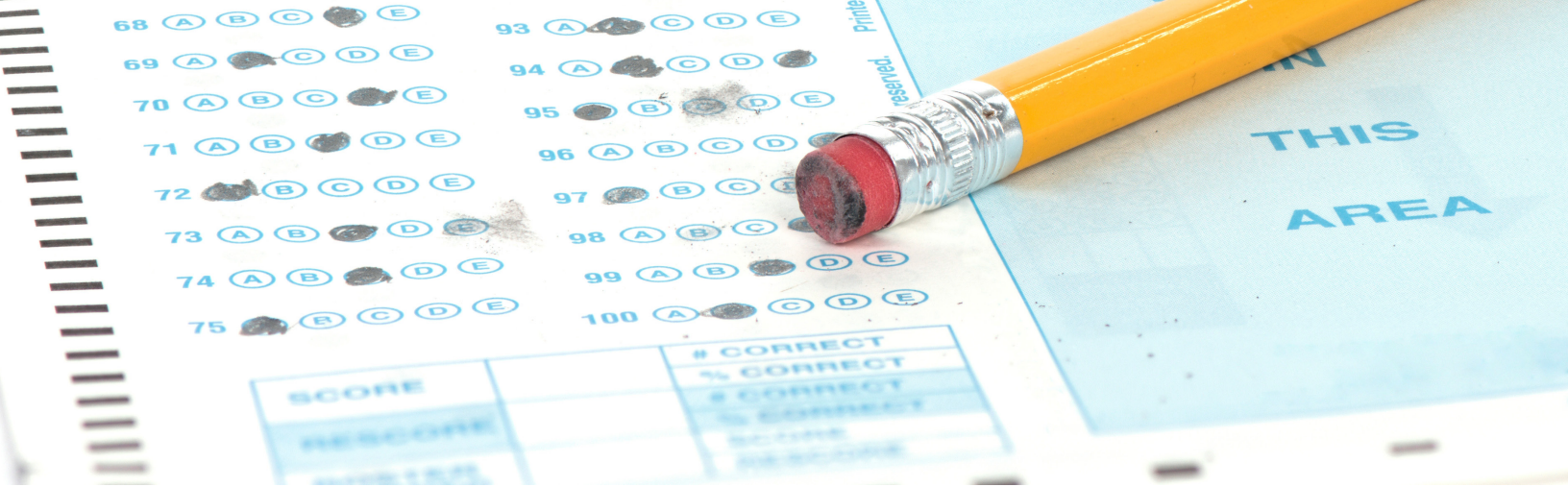
