Gateway students participated in the Cyber Security Capture The Flag Event at St. Louis Community College at Florissant Valley on October 18th.

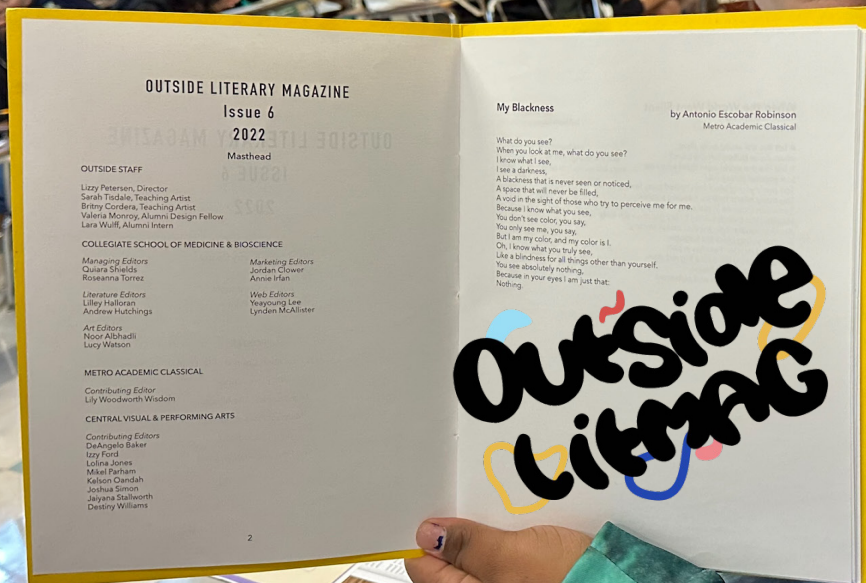
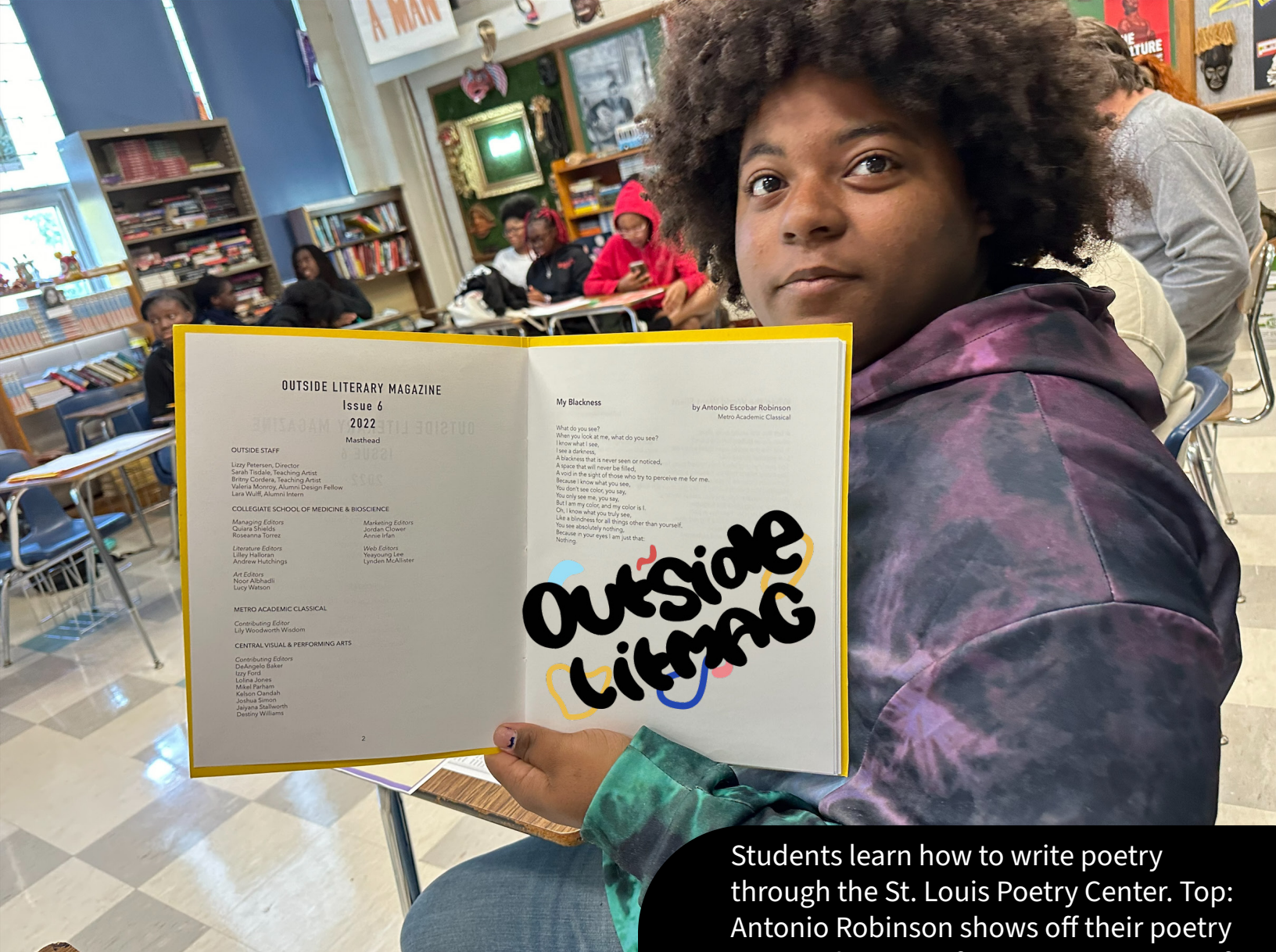

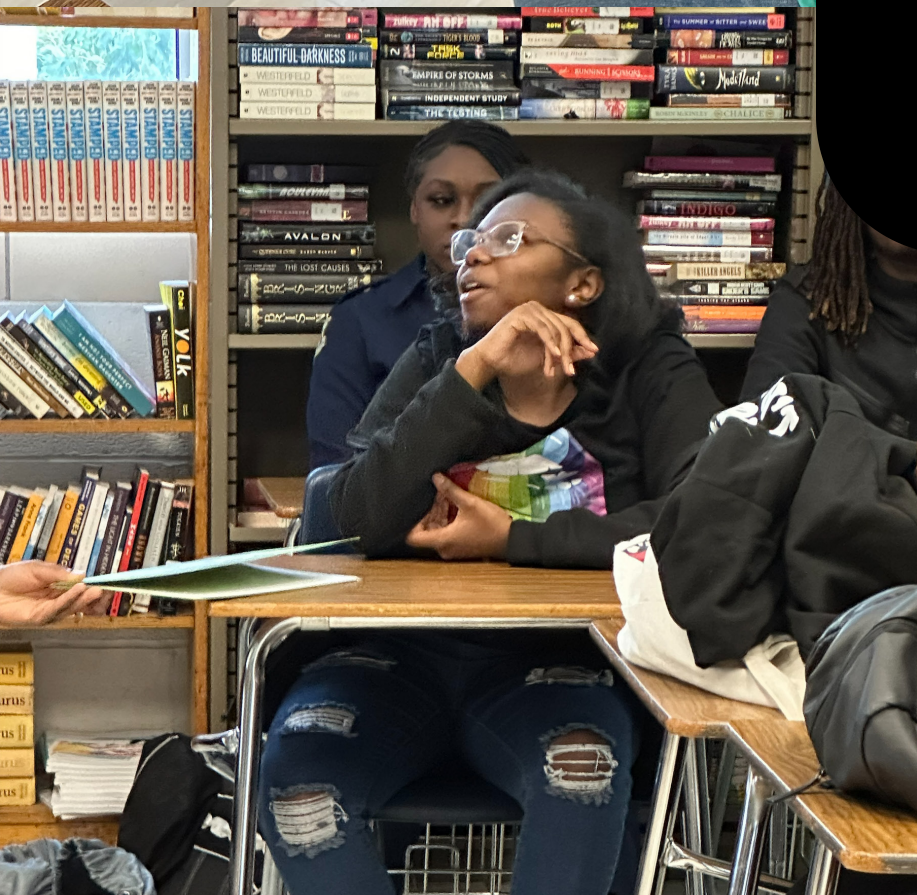




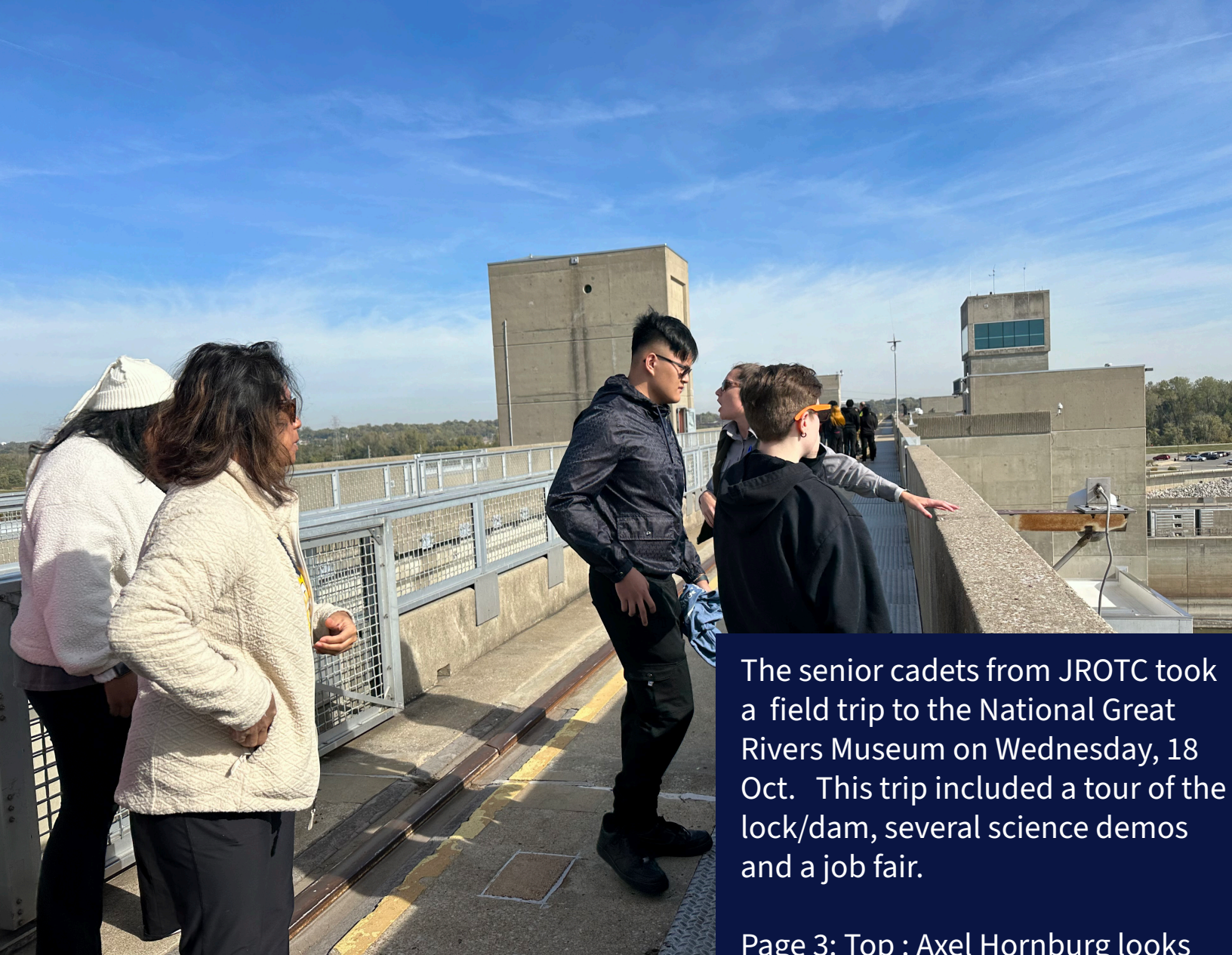

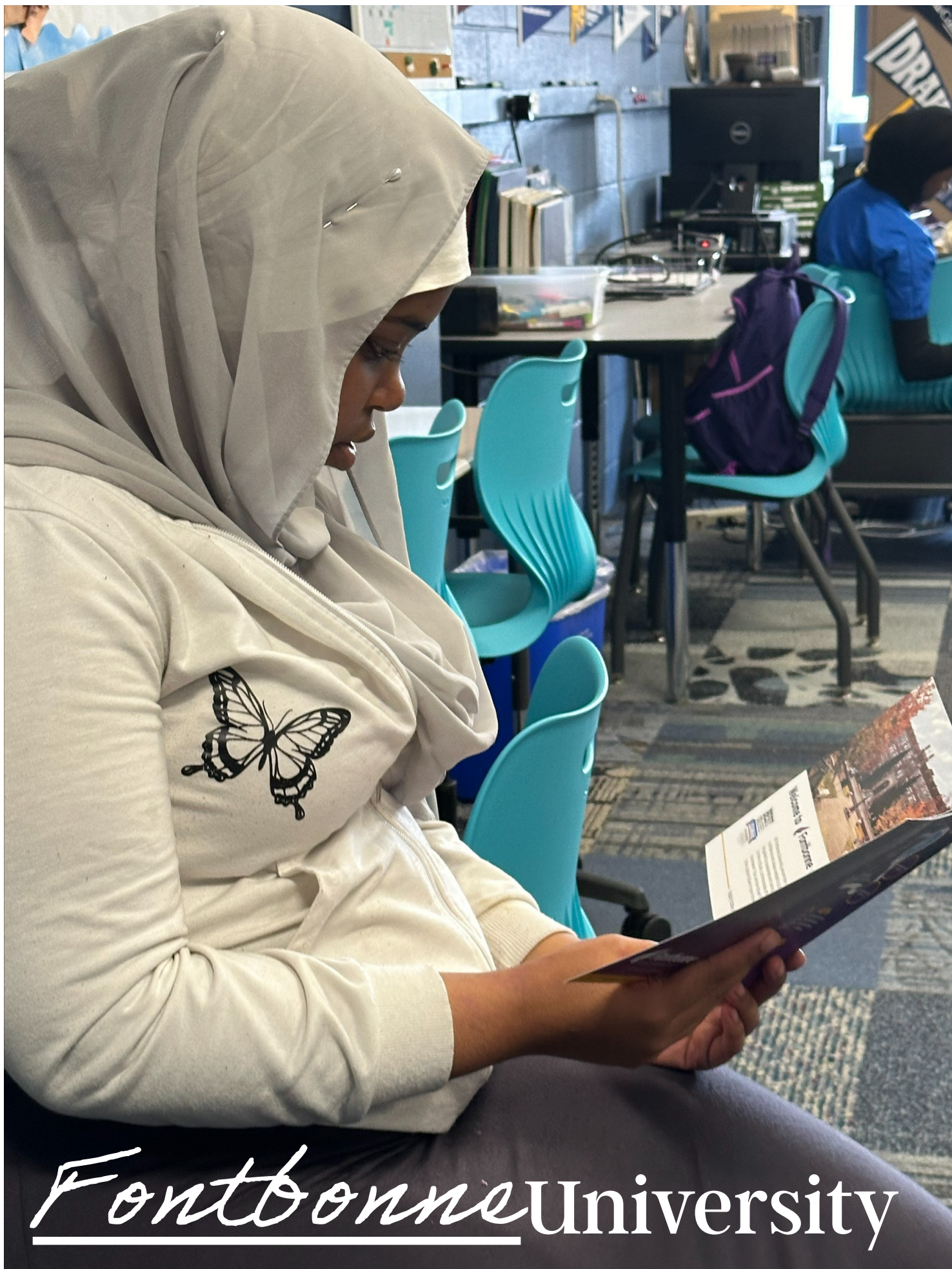

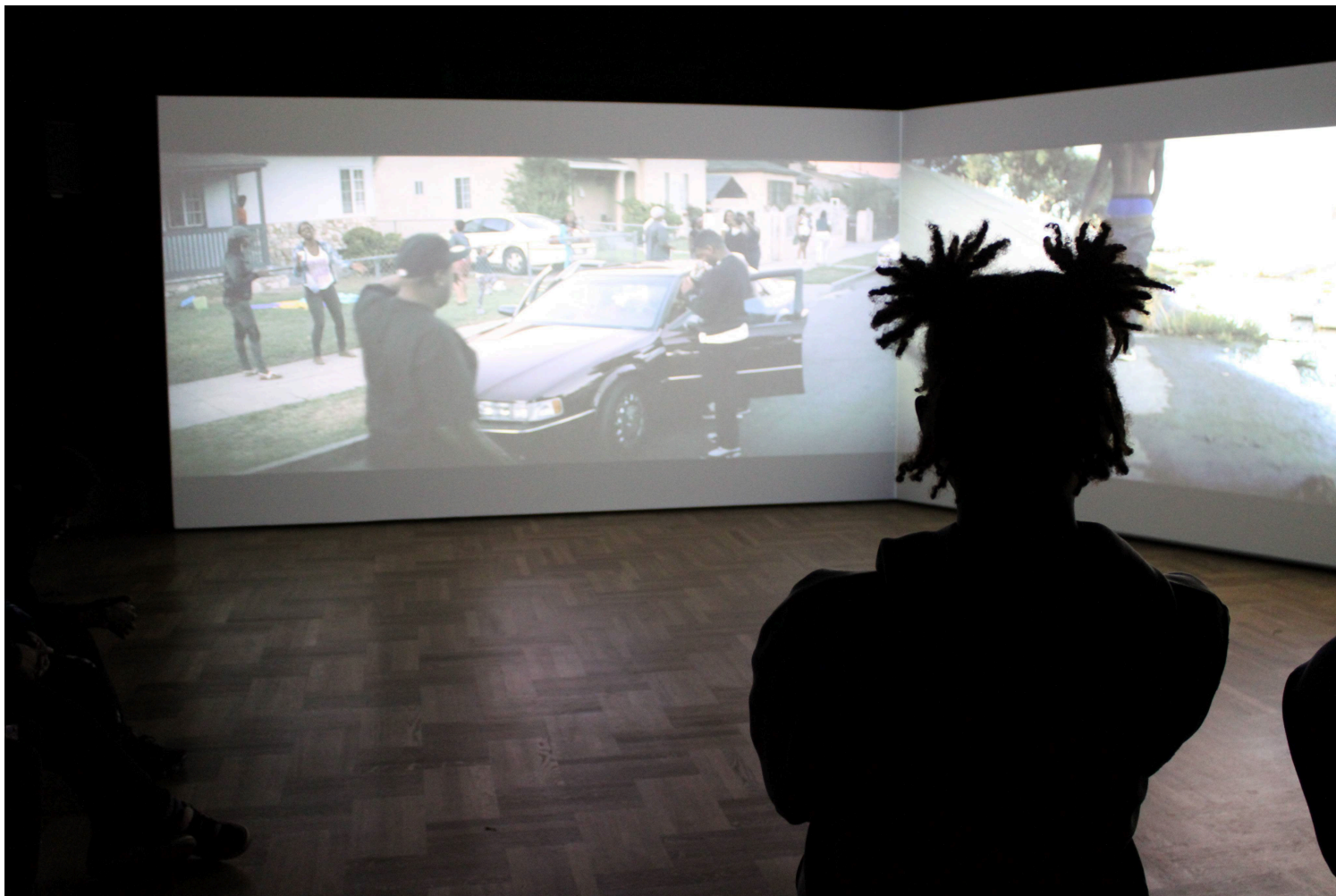

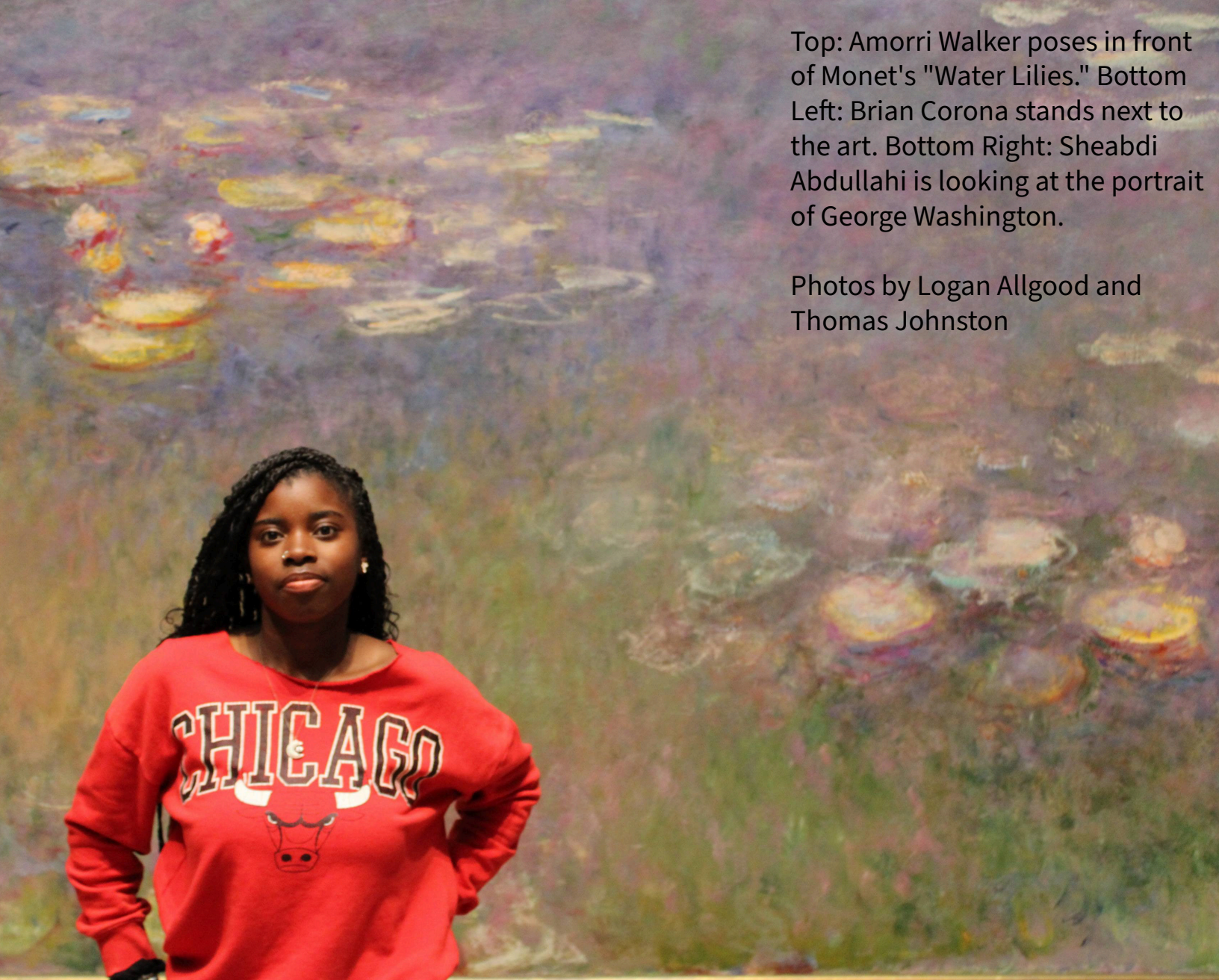
