







Dr. J.A. Salaam

On February 23, five students from our Project Lead the Way engineering classes were chosen to represent Gateway STEM at the annual PLTW Engineering Design Challenge. Our team competed against 11 other high schools (18 teams total) at the Florissant Valley campus of Saint Louis Community College to see who could design the best structure to withstand a potential earthquake. The structures had to be built by students without any adult input, then tested on a shaker table designed to mimic the forces a building would experience in an earthquake. Our team did a great job at the competition! Their building survived the test without collapsing or falling off the shaker!




