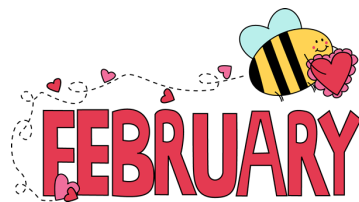

Carr Lane Celebrates Black History Month

In honor of Black History Month, we'd like to recognize Carter Godwin Woodson, known as the Father of Black History Week, what's now known as Black History Month.

Carter G. Woodson

Born Dec. 19, 1875 in New Canton, VA
Died April 3, 1950 in Washington, D.C.

The second African-American to earn a Doctorate degree from Harvard University and one of the first scholars of African-American history.

Was unable to attend school for most of his childhood because he had to help his parents financially. He finally entered high school at age 20 and received his diploma in 2 years.

Founded "Negro History Week" in February 1926

Dedicated his career to the field of African-American history and lobbied to establish Black History Month as a

Absences

As you know, school attendance is required for all children ages six through eighteen. It is our hope that you plan and organize so that being at school on time, is a number-one priority. If you are absent for three (3) consecutive days (unexcused or unexplained absences) or have 3-5 total absences, the school will send a letter to parents/guardians. Further additional absences, excused and/or unexcused, shall be addressed in the following manner: 6-9 absences-2nd letter to parent, 10 or more absences- 3rd parent letter and notification to the Missouri Division of Children's Services, Juvenile Court and /or City Court.

Parents/Volunteers/Visits On Campus

All visitors and volunteers to the campus must sign in at the front desk and are required to wear a name badge. This is a safety requirement and is part of our district and school safety plan.

Dropping Off Students

Please slow down when dropping off your child in the rear of the school door #10 on Carr Street. No students shall enter the front entrance 6:30 am—7:10 am.
