- Continue working on the Color Wheel portion of your drawing and make sure that it is done with only the 3 primary colors.
- Check the Criteria that is listed on what needs to be added to your image.

## Criteria for the Color Wheel:

Make sure that you have the following items included into your assignment and that you are **ONLY USING the 3 Primary Colors, Black, White, and Brown**. You also need to label the colors on the back of the paper.:

1. **Creativity** - 20 pts
2. **Primary, Secondary, and Intermediate Colors** (mixed by using only the 3 primary colors and labeled on the back of your drawing) - 10 pts.
3. **Cool and Warm Colors** (mixed by using only the 3 primary colors and labeled on the back of your drawing) - 10 pts.
4. **Neutral Colors** (labeled on the back of your drawing) - 10 pts.
5. **Tints and Shades** (labeled on the back of your drawing) - 10 pts.
6. **Complementary Colors** (mixed by using only the 3 primary colors and labeled on the back of your drawing) - 10 pts.
7. **Monochromatic** (mixed by using only the 3 primary colors and labeled on the back of your drawing) - 10 pts.

The points for this project is 80 pts.
