WHAT'S THE DEWEY DECIMAL SYSTEM?

The Dewey Decimal System is a system of numbers librarians use to organize books in the library. Each book gets a number based on what it's about.

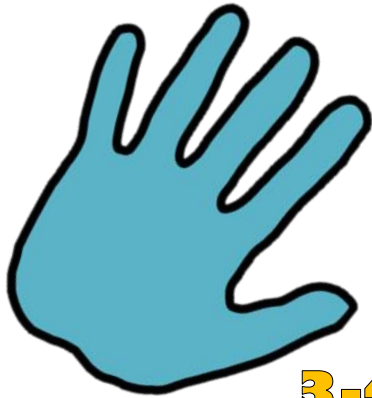


NOW THAT YOU'VE FOUND A BOOK:
TIME TO FIND OUT IF IT'S THE BOOK FOR YOU!



FIVE FINGER RULE

1. Open the book to a random page.
2. Read the page. For every word you don't know, put up one finger.



0 Fingers: Too Easy!

1-2 Fingers: Perfect Choice

3-4 Fingers: Give it a Try

5 Fingers: Too Hard!



TEN PAGE RULE

Read 10 pages of the book. At the end of the first ten pages, ask yourself:

Do I want to finish this book?

Yes?



Great! Finish your book.

No?



Put the book on the return cart and go find a different one.
