The words for this week are: **amicable, compile, exclude, pose** and **coincide.**

- 1. If a relationship is *amicable*, it is friendly. In an *amicable* agreement, people do not argue.
- 2. When you compile information, you collect many different pieces together.
- 3. If someone is *excluded*, they are kept out of something. To *exclude* is to keep something from entering.
- 4. When someone *poses* for a photograph, they sit or stand in a certain way.
- 5. When two events *coincide*, they happen at the same time.
