

Elementary Student Discipline Guide

Definition:
Assault/Battery
An act that causes serious physical harm or creates a substantial risk of serious physical harm to another member of the school community.

Definition:
Sexual Acts
Engaging in intercourse, oral sex, groping sexual parts, or simulated sex

Definition:
Racial Harrassment
Unwanted behavior, speech, written, or pictures directed at someone because of their race, color, or nationality. It is about intimidation, control, misuse of power and the attempt to deny equality. It can be blatant, or subtle, one incident or a pattern.

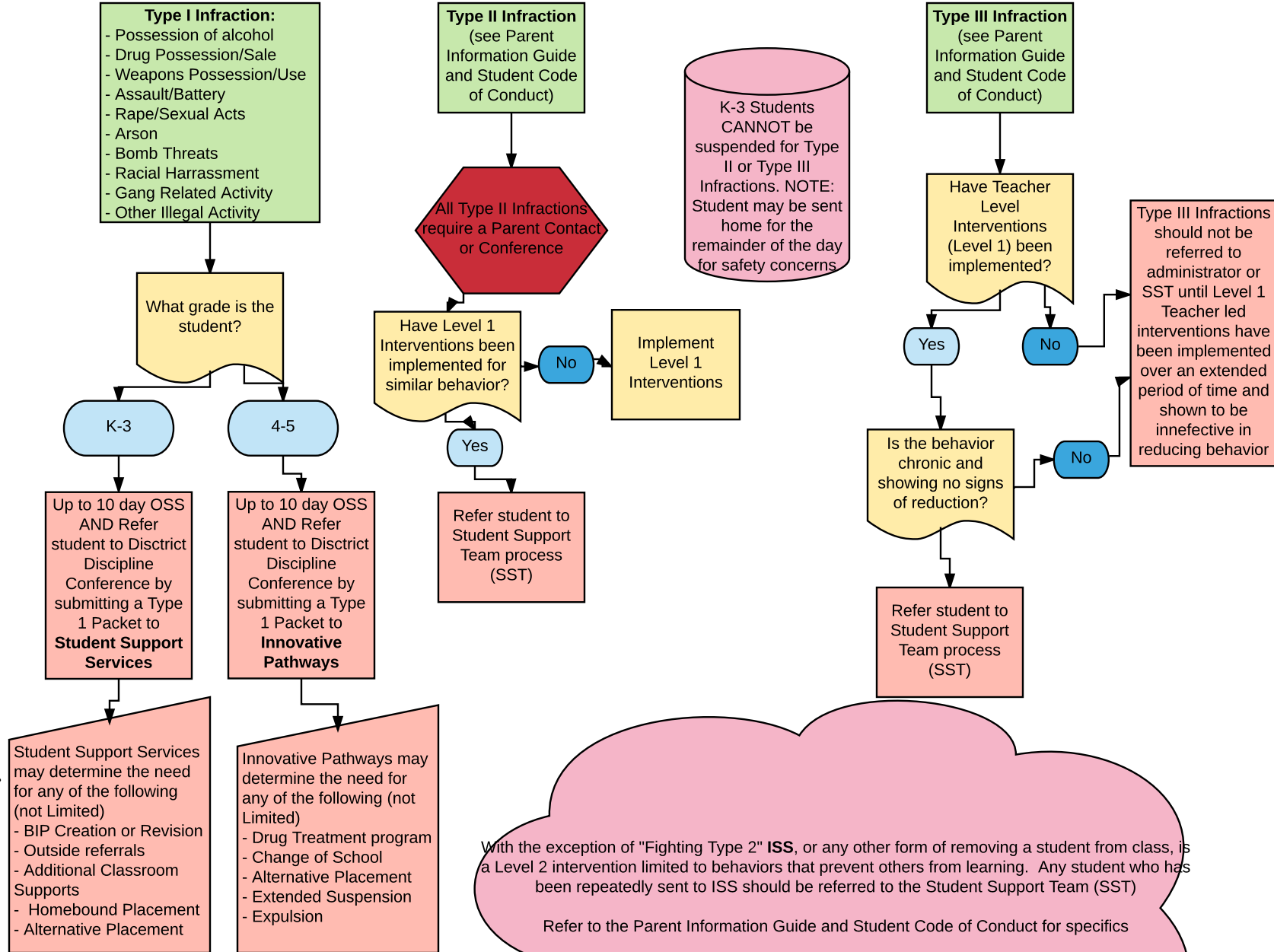

Type I Infraction:
- Possession of alcohol
- Drug Possession/Sale
- Weapons Possession/Use
- Assault/Battery
- Rape/Sexual Acts
- Arson
- Bomb Threats
- Racial Harrassment
- Gang Related Activity
- Other Illegal Activity

Type II Infraction
(see Parent Information Guide and Student Code of Conduct)

Type III Infraction
(see Parent Information Guide and Student Code of Conduct)

K-3 Students CANNOT be suspended for Type II or Type III Infractions. NOTE: Student may be sent home for the remainder of the day for safety concerns



With the exception of "Fighting Type 2" ISS, or any other form of removing a student from class, is a Level 2 intervention limited to behaviors that prevent others from learning. Any student who has been repeatedly sent to ISS should be referred to the Student Support Team (SST)
